A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the issuance and display of one registration
- 2 plate on motor vehicles.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 321.18, subsection 7, Code 2016, is 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 7. Any school bus in this state used exclusively for
- 4 the transportation of pupils to and from school or a school
- 5 function or for the purposes provided in section 285.1,
- 6 subsection 1, and section 285.10, subsection 9, or used
- 7 exclusively for the transportation of children enrolled in a
- 8 federal head start program. Upon application the department
- 9 shall, without charge, issue a registration certificate and a
- 10 registration plates plate. The plates plate shall be attached
- 11 to the front and rear of each bus exempt from registration
- 12 under this subsection.
- 13 Sec. 2. Section 321.22, subsection 1, Code 2016, is amended
- 14 to read as follows:
- 15 1. An urban transit company or system having a franchise
- 16 to operate in any city and any regional transit system may
- 17 make application to the department, upon forms furnished by
- 18 the department, for a certificate containing a distinguishing
- 19 number and for one or more pairs of registration plates to be
- 20 attached to the front and rear of buses owned or operated by
- 21 the transit company or system.
- 22 Sec. 3. Section 321.26, subsection 2, Code 2016, is amended
- 23 to read as follows:
- 24 2. The county treasurer may adjust the renewal or expiration
- 25 date of vehicles when deemed necessary to equalize the number
- 26 of vehicles registered in each twelve-month period or for the
- 27 administrative efficiency of the county treasurer's office.
- 28 The adjustment shall be accomplished by delivery of a written
- 29 notice to the vehicle owner of the adjustment and allowance of
- 30 a credit for the remaining months of the unused portion of the
- 31 annual registration fee, rounded to the nearest whole dollar,
- 32 which amount shall be deducted from the annual registration
- 33 fee due at the time of registration. Upon receipt of the
- 34 notification the owner shall, within thirty days, surrender the
- 35 registration card and registration plates plate to the county

- 1 treasurer of the county where the vehicle is registered, except
- 2 that the registration plates plate shall not be surrendered
- 3 if a validation stickers sticker or other emblems are emblem
- 4 is used to designate the month and year of expiration of
- 5 registration. Upon payment of the annual registration fee,
- 6 less the credit allowed for the remaining months of the
- 7 unused portion of the annual registration fee, the county
- 8 treasurer shall issue a new registration card and registration
- 9 plates plate, validation stickers sticker, or emblems emblem
- 10 which $\frac{\text{indicates}}{\text{indicates}}$ the month and year of expiration of
- ll registration.
- 12 Sec. 4. Section 321.34, subsections 1 and 2, Code 2016, are
- 13 amended to read as follows:
- 14 1. Plates Plate issued. The county treasurer upon receiving
- 15 application, accompanied by proper fee, for registration of a
- 16 vehicle shall issue to the owner one registration plate for
- 17 a motorcycle, motorized bicycle, truck tractor, trailer, or
- 18 semitrailer and two registration plates for every other motor
- 19 vehicle. The registration plates plate, including any special
- 20 registration plates plate, shall be assigned to the owner of a
- 21 vehicle. When the owner of a registered vehicle transfers or
- 22 assigns ownership of the vehicle to another person, the owner
- 23 shall remove the registration plates plate from the vehicle.
- 24 The owner shall forward the plates plate to the county
- 25 treasurer where the vehicle is registered or the owner may have
- 26 the plates plate assigned to another vehicle within thirty days
- 27 after transfer, upon payment of the fees required by law. The
- 28 owner shall immediately affix the registration plates plate
- 29 retained by the owner to another vehicle owned or acquired by
- 30 the owner, providing the owner complies with section 321.46.
- 31 The department shall adopt rules providing for the assignment
- 32 of a registration plates plate to the transferee of a vehicle
- 33 for which a credit is allowed under section 321.46, subsection 34 6.
- 35 2. Validation stickers.

- 1 a. In lieu of issuing a new registration plates plate
- 2 each registration year for a vehicle renewing registration,
- 3 the department may reassign the registration plates plate
- 4 previously issued to the vehicle and may adopt and prescribe
- 5 an annual validation sticker indicating payment of annual
- 6 registration fees. The department shall issue one validation
- 7 sticker for each set of registration plates plate. The
- 8 sticker shall specify the month and year of expiration of the
- 9 registration plates plate. The sticker shall be displayed
- 10 only on the rear registration plate, except that the sticker
- 11 shall be displayed on the front registration plate of a truck
- 12 tractor.
- 13 b. The state department of transportation shall adopt rules
- 14 to provide for the placement of the motor vehicle registration
- 15 validation sticker.
- 16 Sec. 5. Section 321.37, Code 2016, is amended to read as
- 17 follows:
- 18 321.37 Display of plates plate.
- 19 1. Registration plates The registration plate issued for
- 20 a motor vehicle other than a motorcycle, motorized bicycle or
- 21 a truck tractor shall be attached to the rear of the motor
- 22 vehicle, one in the front and the other in the rear. The
- 23 registration plate issued for a motorcycle or other vehicle
- 24 required to be registered hereunder shall be attached to the
- 25 rear of the vehicle. The registration plate issued for a truck
- 26 tractor shall be attached to the front of the truck tractor.
- 27 The special plate issued to a dealer shall be attached on the
- 28 rear of the vehicle when operated on the highways of this
- 29 state.
- 30 2. Registration plates issued for a motor vehicle which
- 31 is model year 1948 or older, and reconstructed or specially
- 32 constructed vehicles built to resemble a model year 1948
- 33 vehicle or older, other than a truck registered for more than
- 34 five tons, motorcycle, or truck tractor, may display one
- 35 registration plate on the rear of the vehicle if the other

- 1 registration plate issued to the vehicle is carried in the
- 2 vehicle at all times when the vehicle is operated on a public
- 3 highway.
- 4 3. It is unlawful for the owner of a vehicle to place
- 5 any frame around or over the registration plate which does not
- 6 permit full view of all numerals and letters printed on the
- 7 registration plate.
- 8 Sec. 6. CODE EDITOR DIRECTIVE. The Code editor may make any
- 9 change the Code editor deems necessary to any Code section that
- 10 refers, in any context, to a set of, a pair of, or two motor
- 11 vehicle registration plates rather than one registration plate,
- 12 when there appears to be no doubt as to the proper method of
- 13 making the correction.
- 14 Sec. 7. TRANSITION PROVISIONS. The transition from the
- 15 use of motor vehicle registration plates on both the front
- 16 and rear of certain vehicles to the use of such plates on
- 17 only the rear of certain vehicles, as directed by this Act,
- 18 shall be accomplished in stages. A person applying for a new
- 19 or replacement registration plate on or after July 1, 2016,
- 20 shall receive only one registration plate. Otherwise, the
- 21 transition shall not be accomplished until a new series of
- 22 registration plates is issued to replace a current series. The
- 23 department of transportation shall adopt rules to implement the
- 24 transition.
- 25 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 28 Under current law, two registration plates are issued for a
- 29 motor vehicle other than a motorcycle, motorized bicycle, or
- 30 truck tractor, and are required to be attached to the front and
- 31 rear of the vehicle.
- 32 This bill provides that only one registration plate shall
- 33 be issued for a motor vehicle. The registration plate shall
- 34 be attached to the rear of the motor vehicle, except that the
- 35 registration plate for a truck tractor shall be attached to the

- 1 front of the truck tractor, in accord with current law.
- 2 The bill also makes corresponding Code language changes,
- 3 directs the Code editor to make changes to language referring
- 4 to two registration plates rather than one, and provides for
- 5 the transition from the use of two registration plates to the
- 6 use of one registration plate.
