

**House File 2173 - Introduced**

HOUSE FILE 2173

**A BILL FOR**

1 An Act relating to open enrollment by requiring the payment of  
2 certain moneys received from the secure an advanced vision  
3 for education fund.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 282.18, subsection 7, Code 2016, is  
2 amended to read as follows:

3 7. a. A pupil participating in open enrollment shall be  
4 counted, for state school foundation aid purposes, in the  
5 pupil's district of residence. A pupil's residence, for  
6 purposes of [this section](#), means a residence under section  
7 282.1. The board of directors of the district of residence  
8 shall pay to the receiving district the state cost per pupil  
9 for the previous school year, and the teacher leadership  
10 supplement state cost per pupil for the previous fiscal year  
11 as provided in [section 257.9](#), plus any moneys received for  
12 the pupil as a result of the non-English speaking weighting  
13 under [section 280.4, subsection 3](#), for the previous school  
14 year multiplied by the state cost per pupil for the previous  
15 year. If the pupil participating in open enrollment is also  
16 an eligible pupil under [section 261E.6](#), the receiving district  
17 shall pay the tuition reimbursement amount to an eligible  
18 postsecondary institution as provided in [section 261E.7](#).

19 b. For school years beginning on or after July 1, 2017,  
20 for each pupil participating in open enrollment, the board of  
21 directors of the district of residence shall also pay to the  
22 receiving district from the total amount received under section  
23 423F.2 an amount equal to the per pupil amount distributed to  
24 the district of residence from the secure an advanced vision  
25 for education fund under section 423F.2, subsection 3, for  
26 the previous school year. Moneys received by the receiving  
27 district under this paragraph shall be used solely for the  
28 purposes authorized under chapter 423F.

29 EXPLANATION

30 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with  
31 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

32 Current Code section 282.18 provides that as a condition  
33 of open enrollment the board of directors of the district of  
34 residence shall pay to the receiving district the state cost  
35 per pupil for the previous school year, the teacher leadership

1 supplement state cost per pupil for the previous fiscal  
2 year, and moneys received for the pupil as a result of the  
3 non-English speaking supplementary weighting for the previous  
4 school year.

5 This bill provides that for school years beginning on  
6 or after July 1, 2017, for each pupil participating in  
7 open enrollment, the board of directors of the district of  
8 residence shall also pay to the receiving district from the  
9 total amount received from the secure an advanced vision  
10 for education (SAVE) fund an amount equal to the per pupil  
11 amount distributed to the district of residence from the SAVE  
12 fund for the previous school year. Moneys received by the  
13 receiving district under the bill must be used solely for the  
14 purposes authorized under Code chapter 423F (statewide school  
15 infrastructure funding).
