## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the use of special minor's driver's
- 2 licenses to travel to private facilities for the purpose of
- 3 participating in extracurricular activities.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 321.194, subsection 1, paragraph a, Code
- 2 2016, is amended by adding the following new subparagraph:
- 3 NEW SUBPARAGRAPH. (03) During the hours of 5:00 a.m.
- 4 to 10:00 p.m. over the most direct and accessible route
- 5 between the licensee's residence or school of enrollment and
- 6 a private facility, within or contiguous to the licensee's
- 7 district of residence, that the licensee's school or district
- 8 has contracted with for the purpose of providing practice
- 9 or competition facilities for the school's extracurricular
- 10 activities.
- 11 Sec. 2. Section 321.194, subsection 1, paragraph a,
- 12 subparagraph (3), Code 2016, is amended to read as follows:
- 13 (3) To a service station for the purpose of refueling, so
- 14 long as the service station is the station closest to the route
- 15 the licensee is traveling on under subparagraph (1), or (2),
- 16 or (03).
- 17 EXPLANATION
- 18 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
- 19 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 20 Under current law, the holder of a special minor's driver's
- 21 license may travel between the licensee's residence or
- 22 school of enrollment and another school for the purpose of
- 23 participating in extracurricular activities.
- 24 This bill allows the holder of a special minor's driver's
- 25 license to also travel between the licensee's residence
- 26 or school of enrollment and a private facility, within or
- 27 contiguous to the licensee's district of residence, that the
- 28 licensee's school or district has contracted with for the
- 29 purpose of providing practice or competition facilities for the
- 30 school's extracurricular activities.
