## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to gross weight limits on interstate and
- 2 noninterstate highways.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

## H.F. 2258

- 1 Section 1. Section 321.463, Code 2016, is amended by adding 2 the following new subsection:
- 3 NEW SUBSECTION. 13A. Notwithstanding this section or any
- 4 other provision of law to the contrary, a motor vehicle with
- 5 a gross weight of more than eighty thousand pounds traveling
- 6 on a noninterstate highway in compliance with this section may
- 7 travel on an interstate highway without violating the gross
- 8 weight limit requirements of this section in order to continue
- 9 traveling on the noninterstate highway, if continued travel on
- 10 the noninterstate highway reasonably requires the vehicle to
- 11 travel on the interstate highway for less than five miles.
- 12 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 15 This bill provides that a motor vehicle with a gross weight
- 16 of more than 80,000 pounds traveling on a noninterstate highway
- 17 in compliance with Code section 321.463 may travel on an
- 18 interstate highway without violating interstate highway gross
- 19 weight limit requirements in order to continue traveling on the
- 20 noninterstate highway, if continued travel on the noninterstate
- 21 highway reasonably requires the vehicle to travel on the
- 22 interstate highway for less than five miles.
- 23 Because the bill allows motor vehicles with a gross weight
- 24 of more than 80,000 pounds to travel on interstate highways,
- 25 Iowa's federal aid road funding may be affected.
