A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to street rods and custom motor vehicles, and
- 2 making penalties and fees applicable.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1	DIVISION I
2	STREET RODS AND CUSTOM VEHICLES
3	Section 1. Section 321.1, Code 2015, is amended by adding
4	the following new subsection:
5	NEW SUBSECTION. 16A. "Custom vehicle" means any car or
6	motor truck with a gross vehicle weight rating of less than ter
7	thousand pounds required to be registered under this chapter,
8	with a model year that is at least twenty-five years old and
9	that was manufactured by a generally recognized manufacturer
10	of motor vehicles after 1948, which may contain a body or
11	frame not manufactured by the original manufacturer or which
12	may be altered from the manufacturer's original design, or
13	any motor vehicle designed and manufactured to resemble a
14	motor vehicle with a model year that is at least twenty-five
15	years old and that was manufactured by a generally recognized
16	manufacturer of motor vehicles after 1948. For purposes of
17	vehicle registration, the model year of a custom vehicle shall
18	be the same as the model year of the motor vehicle that it is
19	designed to resemble.
20	Sec. 2. Section 321.1, subsection 59, Code 2015, is amended
21	to read as follows:

- 2 Sec. 4. Section 321.1, subsection 78A, Code 2015, is amended
- 3 to read as follows:
- 4 78A. "Street rod" means any car or motor truck with a
- 5 gross vehicle weight rating of less than ten thousand pounds
- 6 required to be registered under this chapter, manufactured
- 7 by a generally recognized manufacturer of motor vehicles
- 8 prior to the year 1949, which may contain a body or frame not
- 9 manufactured by the original manufacturer or which may be
- 10 altered from the manufacturer's original design, or any motor
- 11 vehicle designed and manufactured to resemble a motor vehicle
- 12 manufactured prior to the year 1949. For purposes of vehicle
- 13 registration, the model year of a street rod shall be the same
- 14 as the model year of the motor vehicle that it is designed to
- 15 resemble.
- 16 Sec. 5. Section 321.23, subsection 1, Code 2015, is amended
- 17 to read as follows:
- 18 1. a. If the In the application for a motor vehicle to be
- 19 registered is as a specially constructed vehicle, reconstructed
- 20 vehicle, street rod, replica vehicle, custom vehicle, or
- 21 foreign vehicle, such fact shall be stated in the application
- 22 all of the following shall be included:
- 23 (1) A statement that the vehicle to be registered is a
- 24 specially constructed vehicle, reconstructed vehicle, street
- 25 rod, replica vehicle, custom vehicle, or foreign vehicle.
- 26 (2) A statement that the vehicle will be maintained for
- 27 occasional transportation or exhibition in club activities,
- 28 parades, tours, or other similar uses, but will not be operated
- 29 for general, everyday transportation.
- 30 (3) A fee of ten dollars shall be paid by the person making
- 31 the application upon issuance of a certificate of title by
- 32 the county treasurer. For a specially constructed vehicle,
- 33 reconstructed vehicle, street rod, or replica vehicle subject
- 34 to registration, the application shall be accompanied by a
- 35 (4) A statement from the department authorizing the motor

1 vehicle to be titled and registered in this state. 2 (5) Proof that the vehicle passed a safety inspection 3 approved by the department. The department shall adopt rules 4 regarding the form of the proof and the requirements of the 5 safety inspection required by this subparagraph. The department shall cause a physical inspection to 7 be made of all specially constructed vehicles, reconstructed 8 vehicles, street rods, custom vehicles, and replica vehicles 9 upon application for a certificate of title by the owner, 10 to determine whether the motor vehicle complies with the 11 definition of specially constructed vehicle, reconstructed 12 vehicle, street rod, custom vehicle, or replica vehicle in this 13 chapter and to determine that the integral component parts 14 are properly identified and that the rightful ownership is 15 established before issuing the owner the authority to have 16 the motor vehicle registered and titled. The purpose of the 17 physical inspection under this section is not to determine 18 whether the motor vehicle is in a condition safe to operate. The owner of a specially constructed vehicle, 20 reconstructed vehicle, street rod, custom vehicle, or replica 21 vehicle shall apply for a certificate of title and registration 22 for the vehicle at the county treasurer's office within thirty 23 days of the inspection inspections required by paragraph "a", 24 subparagraph (5), and paragraph b''. For a foreign vehicle 25 which has been registered outside this state, the owner 26 shall surrender to the treasurer all registration plates, 27 registration cards, and certificates of title, or if the 28 vehicle to be registered is from a nontitle state, the evidence 29 of foreign registration and ownership as may be prescribed by 30 the department except as provided in subsection 2.

Upon completion of every specially constructed vehicle, 32 reconstructed vehicle, street rod, custom vehicle, or replica 33 vehicle, the owner shall certify on a form prescribed by 34 the department that such vehicle is in compliance with all

35 equipment specifications required under this chapter.

- 1 Sec. 6. Section 321.115A, subsection 1, Code 2015, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- A motor vehicle may be registered as a replica vehicle,
- 4 custom vehicle, or street rod. The annual registration fee
- 5 is the fee provided for in section 321.109, 321.113, 321.122,
- 6 or 321.124. The owner of a vehicle registered under this
- 7 section may display registration plates from or representing
- 8 the model year of the motor vehicle or the model year of the
- 9 motor vehicle the registered vehicle is designed to resemble,
- 10 furnished by the person and approved by the department, in
- 11 lieu of the current and valid Iowa registration plates issued
- 12 for the vehicle, provided that the current and valid Iowa
- 13 registration plates and the registration card issued for the
- 14 vehicle are simultaneously carried within the vehicle and
- 15 are available for inspection to any peace officer upon the
- 16 officer's request.
- 17 Sec. 7. Section 321.115A, Code 2015, is amended by adding
- 18 the following new subsection:
- 19 NEW SUBSECTION. 2A. Notwithstanding any other provision
- 20 of law to the contrary, a motor vehicle registered under
- 21 this section is exempt from periodic vehicle inspections and
- 22 emissions requirements imposed by the laws of this state.
- 23 DIVISION II
- 24 SIGNAL LAMPS AND LIGHTING DEVICES
- 25 Sec. 8. Section 321.1, Code 2015, is amended by adding the
- 26 following new subsection:
- 27 NEW SUBSECTION. 06A. "Blue dot tail light" means a red
- 28 lamp installed in the rear of a street rod or custom vehicle,
- 29 containing a blue or purple insert no more than one inch in
- 30 diameter, and used for a rear lamp, rear signal lamp, rear
- 31 hazard lamp, or rear reflector.
- 32 Sec. 9. Section 321.387, Code 2015, is amended to read as
- 33 follows:
- 34 321.387 Rear lamps.
- 35 Every motor vehicle and every vehicle which is being drawn at

- 1 the end of a train of vehicles shall be equipped with a lighted
- 2 rear lamp or lamps, exhibiting a red light plainly visible from
- 3 a distance of five hundred feet to the rear. The light shall be
- 4 red unless the vehicle is a street rod or custom vehicle with
- 5 a blue dot tail light, in which case the light shall be red,
- 6 blue, or purple. All lamps and lighting equipment originally
- 7 manufactured on a motor vehicle shall be kept in working
- 8 condition or shall be replaced with equivalent equipment.
- 9 Sec. 10. Section 321.393, subsection 2, Code 2015, is
- 10 amended to read as follows:
- 11 2. No lighting device or reflector, when mounted on or
- 12 near the rear of any motor truck or trailer, shall display any
- 13 other color than red, except that the stop light may be red,
- 14 yellow, or amber, or if the motor truck is a street rod or
- 15 custom vehicle with a blue dot tail light, the lighting device
- 16 or reflector may be red, blue, or purple.
- 17 Sec. 11. Section 321.395, Code 2015, is amended to read as
- 18 follows:
- 19 321.395 Lamps on parked vehicles.
- 20 Whenever a vehicle is parked or stopped upon a roadway
- 21 or shoulder adjacent to the roadway, outside of a business
- 22 district whether attended or unattended during the times
- 23 mentioned in section 321.384, such vehicle shall be equipped
- 24 with one or more lamps which shall exhibit a white or amber
- 25 light on the roadway side visible from a distance of five
- 26 hundred feet to the front of such vehicle and a red light
- 27 visible from a distance of five hundred feet to the rear,
- 28 except that a street rod or custom vehicle with a blue dot tail
- 29 light may display a red, blue, or purple light from the rear,
- 30 and except that local authorities may provide by ordinance
- 31 or resolution that no lights need be displayed upon any such
- 32 vehicle when stopped or parked in accordance with local parking
- 33 regulations upon a highway where there is sufficient light to
- 34 reveal any person or object within a distance of five hundred
- 35 feet upon such highway. Any lighted headlamps upon a parked

- 1 vehicle shall be depressed or dimmed.
- 2 Sec. 12. Section 321.404, Code 2015, is amended to read as
- 3 follows:
- 4 321.404 Signal lamps and signal devices.
- 5 Every motor vehicle shall be equipped with a signal lamp
- 6 or signal device which is so constructed and located on the
- 7 vehicle as to give a signal of intention to stop, which shall
- 8 be red or yellow in color, which signal shall be plainly
- 9 visible and understandable in normal sunlight and at night
- 10 from a distance of one hundred feet to the rear but shall not
- 11 project a glaring or dazzling light. However, a street rod or
- 12 custom vehicle with a blue dot tail light may display a red,
- 13 blue, or purple signal lamp or signal device from the rear.
- 14 Sec. 13. Section 321.404A, subsection 1, Code 2015, is
- 15 amended to read as follows:
- 16 1. A person shall not operate a motor vehicle, motorcycle,
- 17 or motorized bicycle on the highways of this state if it is
- 18 equipped with a device that restricts the light output of a
- 19 headlamp required under section 321.385 or 321.386, a rear lamp
- 20 required under section 321.387, a signal lamp or signal device
- 21 required under section 321.404, or a directional signal device
- 22 as described in section 321.317. However, a street rod or
- 23 custom vehicle may be equipped with a blue dot tail light.
- 24 Sec. 14. Section 321.422, subsection 1, Code 2015, is
- 25 amended to read as follows:
- 26 1. No person shall drive or move any vehicle or equipment
- 27 upon any highway with any lamp or device thereon displaying
- 28 or reflecting a red light visible from directly in front
- 29 thereof. No person shall display any color of light other than
- 30 red on the rear of any vehicle, except that stop lights and
- 31 directional signals may be red, yellow, or amber, or if the
- 32 vehicle is a street rod or custom vehicle with a blue dot tail
- 33 light, rear lighting devices or reflectors may be red, blue,
- 34 or purple.

      This bill relates to street rods and custom motor vehicles.
      DIVISION I - STREET RODS AND CUSTOM VEHICLES.
 5 law defines "street rod" as a vehicle manufactured prior to
 6 the year 1949, or any vehicle designed and manufactured to
 7 resemble a vehicle manufactured prior to the year 1949.
 8 bill defines "custom vehicle" as a vehicle with a model year
 9 that is at least 25 years old and that was manufactured after
10 1948, or any vehicle designed and manufactured to resemble a
11 vehicle with a model year that is at least 25 years old and that
12 was manufactured after 1948.
      Current law sets forth certain requirements for registering
13
14 a vehicle as a street rod. The bill adds two requirements:
15 statement that the vehicle will be maintained for occasional
16 transportation or exhibition in club activities, parades,
17 tours, or other similar uses, but will not be operated for
18 general, everyday transportation, and proof that the vehicle
19 passed a safety inspection approved by the department of
20 transportation by rule. The bill applies the existing
21 requirements and these new requirements to custom vehicles.
22 The bill also applies other existing requirements for street
23 rods to custom vehicles, including a non-safety-related
24 physical inspection, a 30-day window after an inspection during
25 which the vehicle owner may register the vehicle as a street
26 rod or custom vehicle, and a safety inspection and fee required
27 for vehicles that do not meet certain equipment requirements.
      The bill provides that the registration fee for custom
28
29 vehicles is determined the same way as the registration fee for
30 street rods, and provides that street rods and custom vehicles
31 are exempt from periodic vehicle inspections and emissions
32 requirements imposed by Iowa law.
      DIVISION II - SIGNAL LAMPS AND LIGHTING DEVICES.
34 bill defines "blue dot tail light" as a red lamp installed

35 in the rear of a street rod or custom vehicle, containing a

- 1 blue or purple insert no more than one inch in diameter, and
- 2 used for a rear lamp, rear signal lamp, rear hazard lamp, or
- 3 rear reflector. The bill provides that street rods and custom
- 4 vehicles may use blue dot tail lights.
