A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the reimbursement amount paid to dealers

2 or persons operating redemption centers who redeem empty

- 3 beverage containers.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 455C.2, subsection 2, Code 2015, is
2 amended to read as follows:

2. In addition to the refund value provided in subsection 4 1 of this section, a dealer, or person operating a redemption 5 center who redeems empty beverage containers or a dealer agent 6 shall be reimbursed by the distributor required to accept the 7 empty beverage containers an amount which is <u>one cent two cents</u> 8 per container. A dealer, dealer agent, or person operating a 9 redemption center may compact empty metal beverage containers 10 with the approval of the distributor required to accept the 11 containers.

EXPLANATION

13The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with14the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

15 This bill increases the reimbursement amount received by 16 a dealer or person operating a redemption center who redeems 17 empty beverage containers from 1 cent per container to 2 cents 18 per container. The reimbursement amount, commonly referred 19 to as a handling fee, is paid by the distributor who collects 20 the beverage containers from the dealer or person operating a 21 redemption center.
