- 1 An Act requiring a comprehensive study on alcoholic beverage
- 2 control.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL COMPREHENSIVE
 2 STUDY.
- The alcoholic beverages division of the department of
- 4 commerce, in collaboration with the office of the attorney
- 5 general and interested stakeholders, shall conduct a
- 6 comprehensive study concerning alcoholic beverage control,
- 7 to include consideration of the manner of properly balancing
- 8 appropriate regulation of the manufacturing, distribution, and
- 9 sale of alcoholic liquor, wine, and beer in this state with
- 10 emerging trends in the industry.
- 11 2. In conducting the study, the division shall consider,
- 12 among any other relevant issues the division identifies
- 13 for study, issues relating to the three-tiered system as it
- 14 impacts the ability of manufacturers and retailers to meet
- 15 changing marketplace conditions and business opportunities, the
- 16 marketing of beer, wine, and alcoholic liquor manufactured in
- 17 this state, and the manner of licensing and regulating liquor
- 18 licensees and wine and beer permittees in this state.
- 19 3. The division shall submit an interim report on the
- 20 study, including any findings and recommendations, to the
- 21 general assembly by December 31, 2016. The division shall
- 22 submit a final report on the results of the study, including
- 23 any findings and recommendations, to the general assembly by
- 24 January 31, 2017.
- 25 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 28 This bill requires the alcoholic beverages division of the
- 29 department of commerce, in collaboration with the attorney
- 30 general and interested stakeholders, to conduct a comprehensive
- 31 study concerning alcoholic beverage control, and to submit to
- 32 the general assembly an interim report on the study by December
- 33 31, 2016, and a final report by January 31, 2017.
