- 1 An Act relating to continuation or reenrollment in accident or
- 2 health care coverage by certain adult dependents of insureds
- 3 or enrollees and including effective date provisions.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 509.3, subsection 1, paragraph h, Code 2 2016, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 h. A provision that the insurer will permit continuation
- 4 of existing coverage or reenrollment in previously existing
- 5 coverage for an individual who meets the requirements of
- 6 section 513B.2, subsection 14, paragraph "a", "b", "c", "d", or
- 7 "e", and who is an unmarried a child of an insured or enrollee
- 8 who so elects, at least through the policy anniversary date
- 9 on or after until the date the child marries, ceases to be
- 10 a resident of this state, or attains the age of twenty-five
- 11 twenty-six years old, whichever occurs first, or so long as the
- 12 unmarried child maintains full-time status as a student in an
- 13 accredited institution of postsecondary education.
- 14 Sec. 2. Section 509A.13B, Code 2016, is amended to read as
- 15 follows:
- 16 509A.13B Coverage of children continuation or
- 17 reenrollment.
- 18 If a governing body, a county board of supervisors, or a
- 19 city council has procured accident or health care coverage for
- 20 its employees under this chapter, such coverage shall permit
- 21 continuation of existing coverage or reenrollment in previously
- 22 existing coverage for an individual who meets the requirements
- 23 of section 513B.2, subsection 14, paragraph "a", "b", "c",
- 24 "d", or "e", and who is an unmarried a child of an insured or
- 25 enrollee who so elects, at least through the policy anniversary
- 26 date on or after until the date the child marries, ceases to
- 27 be a resident of this state, or attains the age of twenty-five
- 28 twenty-six years old, whichever occurs first, or so long as the
- 29 unmarried child maintains full-time status as a student in an
- 30 accredited institution of postsecondary education.
- 31 Sec. 3. Section 514A.3B, subsection 2, Code 2016, is amended
- 32 to read as follows:

- 14 A health maintenance organization which provides health care
- 15 coverage pursuant to an individual or group health maintenance
- 16 organization contract regulated under this chapter for
- 17 children of an enrollee shall permit continuation of existing
- 18 coverage or reenrollment in previously existing coverage for
- 19 an individual who meets the requirements of section 513B.2,
- 20 subsection 14, paragraph "a", "b", "c", "d", or "e", and who
- 21 is an unmarried a child of an enrollee who so elects, at least
- 22 through the policy anniversary date on or after until the date
- 23 the child marries, ceases to be a resident of this state, or
- 24 attains the age of twenty-five twenty-six years old, whichever
- 25 occurs first, or so long as the unmarried child maintains
- 26 full-time status as a student in an accredited institution of
- 27 postsecondary education.
- 28 Sec. 5. EFFECTIVE UPON ENACTMENT. This Act, being deemed of
- 29 immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment.
- 30 EXPLANATION
- 31 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
- 32 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 33 This bill relates to continuation or reenrollment of certain
- 34 adult children of insureds or enrollees in accident or health
- 35 care coverage. The bill requires accident or health care

- 1 coverage to allow an adult child to continue or reenroll in
- 2 such coverage regardless of whether the child is married or
- 3 is a resident of the state, until the date the child attains
- 4 the age of 26 years old. The bill also deletes a provision
- 5 that requires such accident or health care coverage to allow an
- 6 unmarried child to continue or reenroll in such coverage for
- 7 so long as the unmarried child is a full-time student in an
- 8 accredited institution of postsecondary education.
- 9 The bill is effective upon enactment.
