A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act concerning veterans preference information.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 35C.9 Veterans preference —
2 information clearinghouse.

3 1. The department of workforce development, in coordination
4 with the department of administrative services, shall establish
5 a clearinghouse for the purpose of providing information to the
6 state, political subdivisions of the state, and veterans who
7 are citizens and residents of the United States, concerning the
8 rights and duties relating to providing veterans preference as
9 required by this chapter.

10 2. The information provided, which shall include a written
11 statement in plain language concerning the rights and duties of
12 this chapter, shall be developed by the department of workforce
13 development in consultation with the office of the attorney
14 general and the department of administrative services. The
15 information provided shall also include information concerning
16 the enforcement of the requirements of this chapter.

17 3. The internet site for the department of workforce
18 development, the department of administrative services, the
19 office of the attorney general, and the department of veterans
20 affairs shall include a link to the information provided
21 pursuant to this section.

22 EXPLANATION

23 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
24 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

25 This bill requires the department of workforce development,
26 in coordination with the department of administrative services,
27 to establish a clearinghouse for the purpose of providing
28 information on Code chapter 35C concerning veterans preference.
29 The bill requires that the department develop the information
30 provided in consultation with the office of the attorney
31 general and department of administrative services and include
32 information concerning the enforcement of the requirements
33 of Code chapter 35C. The bill requires the department of
34 workforce development, department of administrative services,
35 department of veterans affairs, and the office of the attorney

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1 general to include a link on their internet site to the
2 information provided as required by this bill.
