# A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to water quality by modifying the wastewater
- 2 treatment financial assistance program, creating a water
- 3 service excise tax and a related sales tax exemption, making
- 4 appropriations, and including effective date provisions.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 16.134, Code 2016, is amended to read as 2 follows:
- 3 16.134 Wastewater and drinking water treatment financial 4 assistance program.
- 5 l. The Iowa finance authority shall establish and
- 6 administer a wastewater and drinking water treatment financial
- 7 assistance program. The purpose of the program shall be to
- 8 provide financial assistance to enhance water quality. The
- 9 program shall be administered in accordance with rules adopted
- 10 by the authority pursuant to chapter 17A. For purposes of
- 11 this section, "program" means the wastewater and drinking water
- 12 treatment financial assistance program and "committee" means the
- 13 water quality financing review committee created in subsection
  14 9.
- 15 2. A wastewater and drinking water treatment financial
- 16 assistance fund is created and shall consist of appropriations
- 17 made to the fund and transfers of interest, earnings, and
- 18 moneys from other funds as provided by law. Moneys transferred
- 19 to the fund pursuant to section 423G.6 are appropriated to the
- 20 authority for purposes of the program. Moneys in the fund are
- 21 not subject to section 8.33. Notwithstanding section 12C.7,
- 22 subsection 2, interest or earnings on moneys in the fund shall
- 23 be credited to the fund.
- 24 3. Financial assistance under the program shall be used to
- 25 install or upgrade wastewater treatment facilities and systems
- 26 and drinking water treatment facilities and systems, and for
- 27 engineering or technical assistance for facility planning and
- 28 design.
- 29 4. The authority committee shall distribute approve
- 30 financial assistance  $\frac{in}{n}$  from the fund in accordance with the
- 31 following:
- 32 a. The goal of the program shall be to base awards on the
- 33 impact of the grant combined with other sources of financing to
- 34 ensure that sewer rates do not exceed one and one-half percent
- 35 of a community's median household income.

- l b. a. Communities shall be eligible for financial
- 2 assistance by qualifying as Priority shall be given for
- 3 projects in which a disadvantaged community and is seeking
- 4 financial assistance for the installation or upgrade of
- 5 wastewater treatment facilities due to regulatory activity
- 6 by the department of natural resources and drinking water
- 7 treatment facilities. For purposes of this section, the term
- 8 "disadvantaged community" means the same as defined by the
- 9 department.
- 10 c. b. Priority shall be given to projects in which the
- ll financial assistance is used to obtain with financing under the
- 12 water pollution control works and drinking water facilities
- 13 financing program pursuant to section 16.131 or other federal
- 14 or state financing.
- 15 d. c. Priority shall also be given to projects whose
- 16 completion will provide significant improvement to water
- 17 quality in the relevant watershed.
- 18 e. d. Priority shall also be given to communities that
- 19 employ an alternative wastewater treatment technology pursuant
- 20 to section 455B.199C.
- 21 f. e. Priority shall be also be given to those communities
- 22 where sewer or water rates are the highest as a percentage of
- 23 that community's median household income.
- 24 g. f. Financial assistance in the form of grants shall be
- 25 issued on an annual basis.
- 26 h. g. An applicant shall not receive a grant that exceeds
- 27 five hundred thousand dollars.
- 28 5. The authority in cooperation with the department of
- 29 natural resources shall share provide information and resources
- 30 to the committee when the committee is determining the
- 31 qualifications of a community for financial assistance from the
- 32 fund.
- 33 6. The authority shall enter into agreements with financial
- 34 assistance recipients and distribute moneys under the program
- 35 pursuant to financial assistance determinations made by the

- 1 committee. The authority may use an amount of not more than
- 2 four one percent of any moneys appropriated for deposit in the
- 3 fund for administration purposes.
- 4 7. By October 1 of each year, the authority shall submit
- 5 a report to the governor and the general assembly itemizing
- 6 expenditures under the program during the previous fiscal year.
- 7 8. a. Beginning September 1, 2026, and every ten years
- 8 thereafter, a program review committee is established for
- 9 purposes of reviewing the wastewater and drinking water
- 10 treatment financial assistance program. By December 1 of
- 11 the same year, the review committee shall file a report
- 12 with the governor and the general assembly that reviews the
- 13 effectiveness of the program during the prior ten fiscal years.
- 14 b. The program review committee shall consist of the
- 15 following members:
- 16 (1) The governor or the governor's designee.
- 17 (2) The secretary of agriculture or the secretary's
- 18 designee.
- 19 (3) The executive director of the authority or the executive
- 20 director's designee.
- 21 (4) The director of the department of natural resources or
- 22 the director's designee.
- 23 (5) Four members of the general assembly, with two from the
- 24 senate and two from the house of representatives and not more
- 25 than one member from each chamber being from the same political
- 26 party. The two senators shall be designated one member each
- 27 by the president of the senate, after consultation with the
- 28 majority leader of the senate, and by the minority leader of
- 29 the senate. The two representatives shall be designated one
- 30 member each by the speaker of the house of representatives,
- 31 after consultation with the majority leader of the house of
- 32 representatives, and by the minority leader of the house of
- 33 representatives.
- c. Staffing services shall be provided by the authority.
- 35 9. a. A water quality financing review committee is

- 1 created consisting of the secretary of agriculture or the
- 2 secretary's designee, the executive director of the authority
- 3 or the executive director's designee, and the director of the
- 4 department of natural resources or the director's designee.
- 5 b. The committee shall review and approve or deny
- 6 applications for financial assistance under the wastewater
- 7 and drinking water treatment financial assistance program
- 8 established in this section.
- 9 Sec. 2. Section 423.3, Code 2016, is amended by adding the
- 10 following new subsection:
- 11 NEW SUBSECTION. 103. a. The sales price from the sale or
- 12 furnishing by a water utility of a water service in the state
- 13 to consumers or users.
- 14 b. For purposes of this subsection:
- 15 (1) "Water service" means the delivery of water by piped
- 16 distribution system.
- 17 (2) "Water utility" means a public utility as defined in
- 18 section 476.1 that furnishes water by piped distribution system
- 19 to the public for compensation.
- 20 Sec. 3. NEW SECTION. 423G.1 Short title.
- 21 This chapter may be cited as the "Water Service Tax Act".
- 22 Sec. 4. NEW SECTION. 423G.2 Definitions.
- 23 l. All words and phrases used in this chapter and defined in
- 24 section 423.1 have the same meaning given them by section 423.1
- 25 for purposes of this chapter.
- 26 2. As used in this chapter, "water service" and "water
- 27 utility" mean the same as defined in section 423.3, subsection
- 28 103.
- 29 Sec. 5. NEW SECTION. 423G.3 Water service tax.
- 30 An excise tax at the rate of six percent is imposed on the
- 31 sales price from the sale or furnishing by a water utility of a
- 32 water service in the state to consumers or users.
- 33 Sec. 6. NEW SECTION. 423G.4 Exemptions.
- 34 The sales price from transactions exempt from state sales
- 35 tax under section 423.3, except section 423.3, subsection 103,

- 1 is also exempt from the tax imposed by this chapter.
- 2 Sec. 7. NEW SECTION. 423G.5 Administration by director.
- The director of revenue shall administer the water
- 4 service tax as nearly as possible in conjunction with the
- 5 administration of the state sales and use tax law, except that
- 6 portion of the law that implements the streamlined sales and
- 7 use tax agreement. The director shall provide appropriate
- 8 forms, or provide on the regular state tax forms, for reporting
- 9 water service tax liability.
- 10 2. The director may require all persons who are engaged
- 11 in the business of deriving any sales price or purchase
- 12 price subject to tax under this chapter to register with
- 13 the department. The director may also require a tax permit
- 14 applicable only to this chapter for any retailer not
- 15 collecting, or any user not paying, taxes under chapter 423.
- 16 3. Section 422.25, subsection 4, sections 422.30, 422.67,
- 17 and 422.68, section 422.69, subsection 1, sections 422.70,
- 18 422.71, 422.72, 422.74, and 422.75, section 423.14, subsection
- 19 1, and sections 423.23, 423.24, 423.25, 423.31 through
- 20 423.35, 423.37 through 423.42, and 423.47, consistent with the
- 21 provisions of this chapter, shall apply with respect to the tax
- 22 authorized under this chapter, in the same manner and with the
- 23 same effect as if the excise taxes on the sale or furnishing of
- 24 a water service were retail sales taxes within the meaning of
- 25 those statutes. Notwithstanding this subsection, the director
- 26 shall provide for quarterly filing of returns and for other
- 27 than quarterly filing of returns both as prescribed in section
- 28 423.31. All taxes collected under this chapter by a retailer
- 29 or any user are deemed to be held in trust for the state of 30 Iowa.
- 31 Sec. 8. NEW SECTION. 423G.6 Deposit of revenues.
- 32 1. All moneys received and all refunds shall be deposited in
- 33 or withdrawn from the general fund of the state.
- 34 2. Subsequent to the deposit in the general fund of the
- 35 state, the department shall transfer the following amounts

- 1 to the wastewater and drinking water treatment financial
- 2 assistance fund created in section 16.134:
- 3 a. For revenues collected on or after July 1, 2017, but
- 4 before August 1, 2018, one-sixth of the revenues.
- 5 b. For revenues collected on or after August 1, 2018, but
- 6 before August 1, 2019, one-third of the revenues.
- 7 c. For revenues collected on or after August 1, 2019, but
- 8 before August 1, 2020, one-half of the revenues.
- 9 d. For revenues collected on or after August 1, 2020, but
- 10 before August 1, 2021, two-thirds of the revenues.
- 11 e. For revenues collected on or after August 1, 2021, but
- 12 before August 1, 2022, five-sixths of the revenues.
- 13 f. For revenues collected on or after August 1, 2022, one
- 14 hundred percent of the revenues.
- 15 Sec. 9. NEW SECTION. 423G.7 Future repeal.
- 16 This chapter is repealed July 1, 2037.
- 17 Sec. 10. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect July 1,
- 18 2017.
- 19 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 22 This bill relates to water quality by modifying the
- 23 wastewater treatment financial assistance program and creating
- 24 a water service excise tax.
- 25 WATER QUALITY. The bill amends the wastewater treatment
- 26 financial assistance program (program) administered by the
- 27 Iowa finance authority. Currently, the program provides
- 28 financial assistance to install or upgrade wastewater treatment
- 29 facilities and systems, and for engineering or technical
- 30 assistance for facility planning and design. Awards of
- 31 financial assistance are made by the authority. The bill
- 32 adds drinking water treatment facilities and systems to the
- 33 program. The bill also adds reporting and review requirements
- 34 to the program, modifies the permitted use of fund moneys for

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35 administrative purposes, and creates a water quality financing

- 1 review committee to review and approve applications for
- 2 financial assistance under the program.
- 3 WATER SERVICE EXCISE TAX. The bill exempts from the state
- 4 sales tax the sales price from the sale or furnishing by a
- 5 water utility of a water service in the state to consumers or
- 6 users. "Water service" and "water utility" are defined in the 7 bill.
- 8 By operation of Code section 423.6, an item exempt from the
- 9 imposition of the sales tax is also exempt from the use tax
- 10 imposed in Code section 423.5.
- 11 The bill creates an excise tax at the rate of 6 percent
- 12 on the sales price from the sale or furnishing by a water
- 13 utility of a water service in the state to consumers or users.
- 14 Water service tax revenues are deposited in the general fund
- 15 of the state, and the bill requires an increasing portion
- 16 of the water service tax revenues collected each year to be
- 17 transferred to the wastewater and drinking water treatment
- 18 financial assistance fund, beginning with one-sixth of the
- 19 revenues collected on or after July 1, 2017, but before August
- 20 1, 2018, and increasing to one-third, one-half, two-thirds,
- 21 and five-sixths over the next four years. All water service
- 22 tax revenues collected on or after August 1, 2022, will be
- 23 transferred to the wastewater and drinking water treatment
- 24 financial assistance fund. Water service tax revenues
- 25 transferred to the wastewater and drinking water treatment
- 26 financial assistance fund are appropriated to the Iowa finance
- 27 authority for purposes of the wastewater and drinking water
- 28 treatment financial assistance program.
- 29 The director of revenue is required to administer the water
- 30 service tax as nearly as possible in conjunction with the
- 31 administration of the state sales and use tax laws, and, to
- 32 that end, the bill incorporates by reference numerous Code
- 33 sections that relate to general tax administration and the
- 34 sales and use tax laws. The water service tax is repealed July
- 35 1, 2037.

1 The bill takes effect July 1, 2017.
