- 1 Section 1. Section 724.25, subsection 1, Code 2015, is 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 1. As used in section 724.26, the word "felony" means
- 4 any offense punishable in the jurisdiction where it occurred
- 5 by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year, but does not
- 6 include any offense, other than an offense involving a firearm
- 7 or explosive, classified as a misdemeanor under the laws of the
- 8 state and punishable by a term of imprisonment of two years or
- 9 less. "Felony" does not include a deferred judgment that has
- 10 been expunged pursuant to section 907.3 or the applicable law
- ll of the state in which the deferred judgment was entered, or an
- 12 adjudication of a delinquent act that has been sealed under
- 13 section 232.150 or the applicable law of the state in which the
- 14 adjudication of delinquency was entered.
- 15 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 18 This bill relates to the possession, receipt,
- 19 transportation, or dominion and control of firearms, offensive
- 20 weapons, and ammunition by certain persons.
- 21 Current law in Code section 724.26 prohibits a felon from
- 22 possessing, receiving, transporting, or controlling a firearm,
- 23 offensive weapon, and ammunition. The bill provides that a
- 24 person, who has had a felony judgment deferred that has been
- 25 expunged pursuant to Code section 907.3 or under similar
- 26 laws of another state or an adjudication of a delinquent act
- 27 sealed in juvenile court under Code section 232.150 or under
- 28 similar laws of another state, is not a felon for purposes of
- 29 determining whether a violation of Code section 724.26 has
- 30 occurred.
- 31 A felon who violates Code section 724.26 commits a class "D"
- 32 felony.
