A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the state building code.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 103A.8, subsection 1, Code 2015, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- Provide uniform standards and requirements for
- 4 construction, construction materials, and equipment through
- 5 the adoption by reference of applicable national codes where
- 6 appropriate and providing exceptions when necessary the
- 7 most recent international building code developed by the
- 8 international code council. The rules adopted shall include
- 9 provisions imposing requirements reasonably consistent with or
- 10 identical to recognized and accepted standards contained in
- 11 performance criteria.
- 12 Sec. 2. Section 103A.10, subsection 2, Code 2015, is amended
- 13 by adding the following new paragraph:
- 14 NEW PARAGRAPH. e. To all newly constructed residential and
- 15 all newly constructed or renovated commercial buildings and
- 16 structures in this state. However, a governmental subdivision
- 17 of the state may adopt and enforce higher standards than those
- 18 required under the state building code.
- 19 Sec. 3. Section 103A.22, subsection 1, Code 2015, is amended
- 20 to read as follows:
- 21 1. Nothing in this chapter shall be construed as prohibiting
- 22 any governmental subdivision from adopting or enacting any
- 23 building regulations relating to any building or structure
- 24 within its limits, but a governmental subdivision in which
- 25 the state building code has been accepted and is applicable
- 26 shall not have the power to supersede, void, or repeal or make
- 27 more restrictive any of the provisions of this chapter or of
- 28 the rules adopted by the commissioner. This subsection shall
- 29 not apply to energy conservation requirements adopted by the
- 30 commissioner and approved by the council pursuant to section
- 31 103A.8A or 103A.10.
- 32 Sec. 4. IMPLEMENTATION OF ACT. Section 25B.2, subsection
- 33 3, shall not apply to this Act.
- 34 EXPLANATION
- 35 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with

- the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 2 This bill requires that the state building code provide
- 3 uniform standards and requirements for construction,
- 4 construction materials, and equipment through the adoption
- 5 by reference of the most recent international building code
- 6 developed by the international code council. The bill provides
- 7 that the state building code is applicable to all newly
- 8 constructed residential and all newly constructed or renovated
- 9 commercial buildings and structures in the state. The bill
- 10 also provides that a governmental subdivision of the state may
- 11 adopt and enforce higher standards than those required under
- 12 the state building code.
- 13 The bill may include a state mandate as defined in Code
- 14 section 25B.3. The bill makes inapplicable Code section 25B.2,
- 15 subsection 3, which would relieve a political subdivision from
- 16 complying with a state mandate if funding for the cost of
- 17 the state mandate is not provided or specified. Therefore,
- 18 political subdivisions are required to comply with any state
- 19 mandate included in the bill.
