

**House File 500 - Introduced**

HOUSE FILE 500

**A BILL FOR**

1 An Act relating to the issuance of special Olympics license  
2 plates, establishing fees, and making an appropriation.  
3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 321.34, Code 2015, is amended by adding  
2 the following new subsection:

3 NEW SUBSECTION. 11C. *Special Olympics plates.*

4 a. Upon application and payment of the proper fees, the  
5 director may issue special Olympics plates to the owner of a  
6 motor vehicle subject to registration under section 321.109,  
7 subsection 1, motor truck, motor home, multipurpose vehicle,  
8 motorcycle, trailer, or travel trailer.

9 b. Special Olympics plates shall be designed by the  
10 department.

11 c. The special fee for letter-number designated special  
12 Olympics plates is twenty-five dollars. The fee for  
13 personalized special Olympics plates is twenty-five dollars,  
14 which shall be paid in addition to the special fee of  
15 twenty-five dollars. The fees collected by the director under  
16 this subsection shall be paid monthly to the treasurer of  
17 state and deposited in the road use tax fund. The treasurer  
18 of state shall transfer monthly from the statutory allocations  
19 fund created under section 321.145, subsection 2, to the  
20 special Olympics fund created under section 8.8, the amount  
21 of the special fees collected in the previous month for the  
22 special Olympics plates. Notwithstanding section 8.33, moneys  
23 transferred under this subsection shall not revert to the  
24 general fund of the state.

25 d. Upon receipt of the special registration plates, the  
26 applicant shall surrender the current registration plates to  
27 the county treasurer. The county treasurer shall validate  
28 the special registration plates in the same manner as regular  
29 registration plates are validated under this section. The  
30 annual special fee for letter-number designated special  
31 Olympics plates is ten dollars, which shall be paid in addition  
32 to the regular annual registration fee. The annual fee for  
33 personalized special Olympics plates is five dollars, which  
34 shall be paid in addition to the annual special fee and the  
35 regular annual registration fee. The annual special Olympics

1 fees shall be credited as provided under paragraph "c".

2 Sec. 2. Section 321.145, subsection 2, paragraph b,  
3 subparagraph (3), Code 2015, is amended to read as follows:

4 (3) The amounts required to be transferred pursuant to  
5 section 321.34 from revenues available under this subsection  
6 shall be transferred and credited as provided in section  
7 321.34, subsections 7, 10, 10A, 11, 11A, 11B, 11C, 13, 16, 17,  
8 18, 19, 20, 20A, 20B, 20C, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, and 26 for the  
9 various purposes specified in those subsections.

EXPLANATION

11 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with  
12 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

13 This bill provides for the issuance of special Olympics  
14 license plates designed by the department of transportation.  
15 An owner of a motor vehicle may receive special Olympics plates  
16 after paying a \$25 special fee, and a \$10 annual registration  
17 fee. An owner of a motor vehicle may receive personalized  
18 special Olympics plates after paying an additional \$25 special  
19 fee, and an additional \$5 annual registration fee. The  
20 annual registration fees are in addition to the regular annual  
21 registration fee.

22 The fees collected shall be deposited in the road use tax  
23 fund. The treasurer of state shall transfer monthly from the  
24 statutory allocations fund to the special Olympics fund the  
25 amount of the special fees collected in the previous month for  
26 the special Olympics plates.
