A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the distribution of fines imposed by the
- 2 automated enforcement of traffic laws.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 321.1, Code 2015, is amended by adding
- 2 the following new subsection:
- 3 NEW SUBSECTION. 06A. "Automated traffic law enforcement
- 4 system" means a device with one or more sensors working in
- 5 conjunction with one of the following:
- 6 a. An official traffic-control signal, to produce recorded
- 7 images of motor vehicles entering an intersection against a red
- 8 signal light.
- 9 b. A speed measuring device, to produce recorded images of
- 10 motor vehicles traveling at a prohibited rate of speed.
- ll c. A railroad grade crossing signal light, as described in
- 12 section 321.342, to produce images of vehicles violating the
- 13 signal light.
- d. Any official traffic-control device, if failure to comply
- 15 with the official traffic-control device constitutes a moving
- 16 violation under this chapter.
- 17 Sec. 2. NEW SECTION. 321.260A Automated traffic law
- 18 enforcement notice of fine distribution on citation.
- 19 If a local authority issues a citation as a result of an
- 20 image or any other indication of activity obtained from an
- 21 automated traffic law enforcement system, the citation shall
- 22 provide an itemized list of the fines and fees assessed
- 23 pursuant to the citation, the name of each entity that will
- 24 receive a portion of the fines or fees, and the amount of the
- 25 fines or fees that each entity will receive.
- 26 EXPLANATION
- 27 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
- the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 29 This bill defines an automated traffic law enforcement
- 30 system as a device with one or more sensors working in
- 31 conjunction with an official traffic-control signal, a speed
- 32 measuring device, a railroad grade crossing signal light, or
- 33 any official traffic-control device.
- The bill requires that any citation issued by a local
- 35 authority as a result of the use of an automated traffic law

- 1 enforcement system must include an itemized list of the fines
- 2 and fees assessed pursuant to the citation, the name of each
- 3 entity that will receive a portion of the fines or fees, and
- 4 the amount of the fines or fees that each entity will receive.
