HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 117 BY ROGERS, BERRY, and SALMON

1 A Resolution urging the United States Congress to 2 revise legislation impacting and limiting the use of 3 incandescent light bulbs. WHEREAS, incandescent light bulbs have proven to be 4 5 a safe, dependable, and efficient source of lighting 6 for decades; and 7 WHEREAS, consumer choice and consumer freedom is an 8 important component of our free market system; and 9 WHEREAS, Congress enacted the Energy Independence 10 and Security Act in 2007; and 11 WHEREAS, the Act created regulations that, for 12 all practical purposes, banned the use of standard 13 incandescent light bulbs by establishing increased 14 minimum energy efficiency standards for general 15 lamps; and WHEREAS, the overregulation of industry can result 16 17 in limitations on consumer choice and freedom; NOW 18 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, That 19 20 the House of Representatives urges Congress to revise 21 provisions in the Energy Independence and Security 22 Act of 2007 which impacted and limited the use of 23 incandescent light bulbs.
