- 1 Section 1. Section 232.71B, subsection 17, Code 2015, is 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 17. County attorney juvenile court. The department shall
- 4 provide the juvenile court and the county attorney with a copy
- 5 of the written child abuse assessment report, and the written
- 6 family assessment report for cases in which the department
- 7 requests a child in need of assistance petition, or other
- 8 reports for cases in which the department requests a child
- 9 in need of assistance petition. The juvenile court and the
- 10 county attorney shall notify the department of any action taken
- 11 concerning an assessment provided by the department.
- 12 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- An Act relating to the duties of the department of human
- 16 services relating to child abuse and family assessment reports
- 17 in child abuse cases.
- 18 Under current law, the department of human services is
- 19 required to provide the juvenile court and the county attorney
- 20 with a copy of the department's written child abuse assessment
- 21 report, the department's written family assessment report for
- 22 cases in which the department requests a child in need of
- 23 assistance petition, or other reports for cases in which the
- 24 department requests a child in need of assistance petition.
- 25 The bill provides that the department is required to provide
- 26 the juvenile court and the county attorney with a copy of
- 27 the written child abuse assessment report and the written
- 28 family assessment report, regardless of whether the department
- 29 has requested a child in need of assistance petition. The
- 30 department is not required to provide the juvenile court and
- 31 the county attorney additional reports.
