A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the dissemination of contact information
- 2 pertaining to the boards of directors of school districts.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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1 Section 1. Section 279.35, Code 2015, is amended to read as 2 follows:

- 3 279.35 Publication of proceedings and certain other
- 4 information.
- 5 1. Proceedings schedule of bills. The proceedings of
- 6 each regular, adjourned, or special meeting of the board,
- 7 including the schedule of bills allowed, shall be published
- 8 after the adjournment of the meeting in the manner provided in
- 9 this section and section 279.36, and the publication of the
- 10 schedule of the bills allowed shall include a list of claims
- 11 allowed, including salary claims for services performed. The
- 12 schedule of bills allowed may be published on a once monthly
- 13 basis in lieu of publication with the proceedings of each
- 14 meeting of the board. The list of claims allowed shall include
- 15 the name of the person or firm making the claim, the purpose
- 16 of the claim, and the amount of the claim. If the purpose for
- 17 the claims is the same, two or more claims made by the same
- 18 vendor, supplier, or claimant may be consolidated if the number
- 19 of claims consolidated and the total consolidated claim amount
- 20 are listed in the statement. However, the board shall provide
- 21 at its office upon request an unconsolidated list of all claims
- 22 allowed. The secretary shall furnish a copy of the proceedings
- 23 to be published within two weeks following the adjournment of
- 24 the meeting.
- 25 2. Salaries. Salaries paid to individuals regularly
- 26 employed by the district shall only be published annually and
- 27 the publication shall include the total amount of the annual
- 28 salary of each employee. The secretary shall furnish a copy of
- 29 the proceedings to be published within two weeks following the
- 30 adjournment of the meeting.
- 31 3. Member contact information. Within thirty days of the
- 32 first regular meeting of the board of directors, each member
- 33 of the board shall supply to the secretary, and shall update
- 34 at least annually, the member's contact information, which the
- 35 secretary shall cause to be published on the school district's

- 2 Sec. 2. Section 279.36, Code 2015, is amended to read as
- 3 follows:
- 4 279.36 Publication procedures and fee.
- 5 The requirements of section 279.35, subsections 1 and 2, are
- 6 satisfied by publication in at least one newspaper published
- 7 in the district or, if there is none, in at least one newspaper
- 8 having general circulation within the district.
- 9 For the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1987, the fee for
- 10 publications required under section 279.35, subsections 1 and
- 11 2, shall not exceed three-fifths of the legal publication fee
- 12 provided by statute for the publication of legal notices.
- 13 For the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1988, the fee for the
- 14 publications shall not exceed three-fourths of that legal
- 15 publication fee. For the fiscal year beginning July 1,
- 16 1989, and each fiscal year thereafter, the The fee for the
- 17 publications shall be the legal publication fee provided by
- 18 statute set forth in section 618.11.
- 19 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 22 This bill amends Code section 279.35 to provide that within
- 23 30 days of the first regular meeting of the board of directors
- 24 of a school district, each member of the board must supply
- 25 to the board secretary the member's contact information for
- 26 publication on the school district's internet site. Board
- 27 members must update their contact information annually. The
- 28 bill makes corresponding changes.
