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1 Section 1. Section 135.180, subsection 3, Code 2015, is 2 amended to read as follows:
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- 3. a. The program shall provide stipends to support
- 4 psychiatrist positions with an emphasis on securing and

- 6 providers of mental health services to county residents
- 7 pursuant to a waiver approved under section 225C.7, subsection
- 8 3, Code 2011, and hospital psychiatric units that are located
- 9 in mental health professional shortage areas.
- 10 b. The program shall provide stipends to support psychiatric
- 11 positions at nonprofit agencies licensed under chapter 135H
- 12 that provide outpatient mental health services if at least
- 13 fifty percent of the outpatient clients are covered under the
- 14 medical assistance program established in chapter 249A.

- 20 The mental health professional shortage area program
- 21 provides funding to agencies to assist with the recruitment
- 22 and retention of mental health professionals in medically
- 23 underserved areas of Iowa. The program provides stipends to
- 24 support psychiatrist positions with an emphasis on securing and
- 25 retaining medical directors at community mental health centers,
- 26 providers of mental health services to county residents, and
- 27 hospital psychiatric units that are located in mental health
- 28 professional shortage areas.
- 29 The bill provides that the program shall provide stipends to
- 30 support psychiatric positions at nonprofit agencies licensed
- 31 under Code chapter 135H (psychiatric medical institutions for
- 32 children) that provide outpatient mental health services if at
- 33 least 50 percent of the outpatient clients are covered under
- 34 the medical assistance program established in Code chapter
- 35 249A. "Medical assistance" is defined in Code section 249A.2
