A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the development of a hub and spoke recycling
- 2 program and providing for an allocation of moneys from the
- 3 groundwater protection fund.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 455E.11, subsection 2, paragraph a,
- 2 subparagraph (1), Code 2015, is amended by adding the following
- 3 new subparagraph division:
- 4 NEW SUBPARAGRAPH DIVISION. (0a) (i) For the fiscal year
- 5 beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2016, not more
- 6 than two hundred fifty thousand dollars to the department
- 7 for purposes of developing a hub and spoke recycling program
- 8 to create regional recycling processing centers in large
- 9 communities and encourage small communities to deliver
- 10 recyclables to the centers.
- 11 (ii) Each fiscal year for the period beginning July 1,
- 12 2016, and ending June 30, 2020, not more than one million five
- 13 hundred thousand dollars to the department for implementation
- 14 of the hub and spoke recycling program.
- 15 EXPLANATION
- 16 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
- 17 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 18 This bill provides for funding to the department of natural
- 19 resources from the solid waste alternatives program to create
- 20 a hub and spoke recycling program. The program is to create
- 21 regional recycling processing centers in large communities,
- 22 or "hubs", and encourage small communities, or "spokes", to
- 23 deliver recyclables to the centers. The bill allocates to the
- 24 department from the solid waste account of the groundwater
- 25 protection fund created in Code section 455E.11, \$250,000 in
- 26 the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30,
- 27 2016, to develop the program, and \$1.5 million in each fiscal
- 28 year for the period beginning July 1, 2016, and ending June 30,
- 29 2020, to implement the program. The environmental protection
- 30 commission has authority to adopt administrative rules to
- 31 implement Code chapter 455E.
