## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to strip searches of persons housed at a jail
- 2 or municipal holding facility.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 804.30, Code 2015, is amended to read as 2 follows:
- 3 804.30 Strip searches.
- 1. A person housed in the general population of a county
- 5 jail or municipal holding facility may be subject to a strip
- 6 search.
- 7 1. 2. A person arrested for a scheduled violation or a
- 8 simple misdemeanor who is not housed in the general population
- 9 of a county jail or municipal holding facility shall not be
- 10 subjected to a strip search unless there is probable cause
- ll reasonable suspicion to believe the person is concealing a
- 12 weapon or contraband. A strip search pursuant to this section
- 13 subsection shall not be conducted except under all of the
- 14 following conditions:
- 15 a. Written authorization of the supervisor on duty is
- 16 obtained.
- 17 b. A search warrant is obtained for the probing of any body
- 18 cavity other than the mouth, ears, or nose.
- 19 c. A visual search or probing of any body cavity shall
- 20 be performed under sanitary conditions. A physical probe of
- 21 a body cavity other than the mouth, ears, or nose shall be
- 22 performed only by a licensed physician unless voluntarily
- 23 waived in writing by the arrested person.
- d. The search is conducted in a place where it cannot be
- 25 observed by persons not conducting the search.
- 26 e. The search is conducted by a person of the same sex as
- 27 the arrested person, unless conducted by a physician.
- 28 2. f. Subsequent to a strip search pursuant to this
- 29 subsection, a written report shall be prepared which includes
- 30 the written authorization required by subsection 1, paragraph
- 31 "a" this subsection, the name of the person subjected to
- 32 the search, the names of the persons conducting the search,
- 33 the time, date, and place of the search and, if required by
- 34 subsection 1, paragraph "b", a copy of the search warrant
- 35 authorizing the search. A copy of the report shall be provided

- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 5 This bill relates to strip searches of persons housed at a
- 6 jail or municipal holding facility.
- 7 The bill specifies that a person housed in the general
- 8 population of a jail or municipal holding facility may be
- 9 subject to a strip search.
- 10 Current law provides that a person arrested for a scheduled
- 11 violation or simple misdemeanor shall not be subject to a strip
- 12 search unless there is probable cause to believe the person
- 13 is concealing a weapon or contraband. The bill modifies this
- 14 provision to provide that a person who has been arrested for
- 15 a scheduled violation or a simple misdemeanor and who is not
- 16 housed in the general population of a jail or municipal holding
- 17 facility shall not be subjected to a strip search unless there
- 18 is reasonable suspicion the person is concealing a weapon or
- 19 contraband.
- 20 The bill also specifies that a written report shall be
- 21 prepared concerning each strip search of a person who has been
- 22 arrested for a scheduled violation or simple misdemeanor but
- 23 not housed in the general population of the jail.
