- 1 Section 1. The amendment to 645 Iowa administrative code,
- 2 rule 327.4, subrule 2, as appearing in ARC 1909C, as published
- 3 in the Iowa administrative bulletin, volume XXXVII, number 19,
- 4 dated March 18, 2015, p. 1684, is nullified.
- 5 Sec. 2. This joint resolution, being deemed of immediate
- 6 importance, takes effect upon enactment.
- 7 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- This joint resolution nullifies an amendment to an administrative rule adopted by the board of physician
- 12 assistants removing a requirement that a physician supervising
- 13 a physician assistant who is practicing in a remote medical
- 14 site physically visit and practice at the remote medical site
- 15 at least every two weeks. A session delay was imposed on
- 16 this rulemaking by the administrative rules review committee
- 17 in April 2015. By nullifying the amendment to the rule,
- 18 physicians will continue to generally be required to visit
- 19 remote medical sites every two weeks.
- 20 This joint resolution takes effect upon enactment.
