

House Study Bill 630 - Introduced

A BILL FOR

1 An Act requiring security interest and lien checks before the
2 disposal of motor vehicles for scrap or junk.
3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 321.52, subsection 2, paragraph b, Code
2 2016, is amended to read as follows:

3 b. The owner of a motor vehicle subject to registration that
4 does not have a certificate of title or a junking certificate
5 may dispose of the vehicle to a vehicle recycler licensed under
6 chapter 321H for scrap or junk if all of the following apply:

7 (1) The vehicle is twelve model years old or older and.

8 (2) The vehicle is acquired by the vehicle recycler for
9 reasonable consideration equaling less than one thousand
10 dollars.

11 (3) The vehicle does not have any security interests or
12 liens against the vehicle as certified by the county treasurer
13 at the request of the vehicle recycler pursuant to section
14 321.50, subsection 7.

15 EXPLANATION

16 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
17 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

18 Under current law, the owner of a motor vehicle that does
19 not have a certificate of title or a junking certificate may
20 dispose of the vehicle to a vehicle recycler for scrap or junk
21 if the vehicle is 12 model years old or older and is acquired by
22 the vehicle recycler for less than \$1,000. This bill requires
23 that the vehicle must also have no security interests or liens
24 against the vehicle as certified by the county treasurer at the
25 request of the vehicle recycler.
