A BILL FOR

1 An Act preventing executive branch administrative units from
2 collecting additional fees from persons as a result of
3 changing requirements for a professional license or the
4 equivalent.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 7E.4A Authorization to practice
2 profession — collection of additional fees.

3 An executive branch administrative unit that regulates a
4 profession shall only assess a fee for renewal of a license,
5 certificate, registration, or other authorization to practice
6 the profession from a person who holds a current authorization
7 and is in good standing with that administrative unit in
8 accordance with the administrative unit's rules in effect at
9 the time the person acquired or most recently renewed the
10 authorization, regardless of whether the unit modified a
11 requirement for initially obtaining the license during the
12 period for which the person's authorization was valid.

13 EXPLANATION

14 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
15 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

16 This bill prohibits an executive branch administrative unit
17 that regulates a profession from assessing a fee for renewal of
18 a license, certificate, registration, or other authorization
19 to practice the profession from a person who holds a current
20 authorization and is in good standing with that administrative
21 unit in accordance with the administrative unit's rules in
22 effect at the time the person acquired or most recently renewed
23 the authorization, regardless of whether the unit modified a
24 requirement for initially obtaining the license during the
25 period for which the person's authorization was valid.
