1 2 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

3 This bill relates to financial and regulatory matters by 4 supplementing appropriations for the fiscal year beginning July 5 1, 2015, and by making standing appropriations. The bill is 6 organized into divisions.

7 HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES. This division supplements 8 an appropriation from the general fund of the state to the 9 department of health and human services for the fiscal year 10 that begins July 1, 2015, for medical assistance program 11 reimbursement and associated costs. The supplemental 12 appropriation is \$80 million, and nonreversion provisions are 13 made applicable.

14 The division is effective upon enactment.

DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS. This division supplements an appropriation from the general fund of the state to the department of corrections for the fiscal year that begins July 1, 2015, for general administration. The supplemental appropriation is \$1.9 million. The division provides that priority in allocating the funds shall be to supplement other amounts separately appropriated for the operation of the Mount Pleasant and Clarinda correctional facilities. Nonreversion provisions are made applicable.

24 The division takes effect upon enactment.

DEPARTMENT OF INSPECTIONS AND APPEALS. This division supplements an appropriation from the general fund of the state to the office of the state public defender of the department of inspections and appeals for the fiscal year that begins July 1, 2015, for payments from the indigent defense fund. The supplemental appropriation is \$3 million. Nonreversion provisions are made applicable.

32 The division takes effect upon enactment.

33 DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES. This division 34 supplements an appropriation from the general fund of the state 35 to the department of administrative services for the fiscal

year that begins July 1, 2015, for payment of utility costs.
 The supplemental appropriation is \$610,039. Nonreversion
 provisions were made applicable.

4 The division takes effect upon enactment.

5 REBUILD IOWA INFRASTRUCTURE FUND. This division provides 6 that the first \$30 million of moneys in excess of the 7 maximum balance in the Iowa economic emergency fund shall be 8 transferred annually to the rebuild Iowa infrastructure fund to 9 be used as provided in Code section 8.57, subsection 5.

10 The division takes effect July 1, 2017.

11 REBUILD IOWA INFRASTRUCTURE FUND — ONE-TIME APPROPRIATION.
12 This division makes a one-time appropriation of \$30 million
13 from the general fund of the state to the rebuild Iowa
14 infrastructure fund for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2015,
15 and ending June 30, 2016.

16 The division takes effect upon enactment.

17 GAMING REVENUES. This division provides that for the fiscal 18 year beginning July 1, 2016, and for each succeeding fiscal 19 year, the first \$25 million of the total moneys remaining after 20 payments are deducted from appropriations made to the rebuild 21 Iowa infrastructure fund for revenue bond debt service, revenue 22 bond federal subsidy holdback, the vision Iowa fund, and the 23 Iowa skilled worker and job creation fund shall be deposited in 24 the general fund of the state.
