- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. HAWK-I COVERED SPEECH THERAPY BENEFIT UNDER MEDICAID MANAGED CARE CONTRACT. The hawk-i covered speech therapy benefit under Medicaid managed care shall provide for coverage of both habilitative and rehabilitative services for children with speech, language, and hearing disorders as medically necessary. The determination that a service is medically necessary shall not be interpreted to require loss or impairment as the result of a stroke, accidental injury, or surgery to the head or neck as a prerequisite to coverage of services.

11 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE UPON ENACTMENT. This Act, being deemed of 12 immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment.

13 Sec. 3. RETROACTIVE APPLICABILITY. This Act applies 14 retroactively to March 1, 2016.

This bill requires that the hawk-i covered speech therapy benefit under Medicaid managed care provide for coverage of both habilitative and rehabilitative services for children with speech, language, and hearing disorders as medically necessary. The bill prohibits the determination of a service as medically necessary from being interpreted to require loss or impairment as the result of a stroke, accidental injury, or surgery to the head or neck as a prerequisite to coverage of services. The bill takes effect upon enactment and is retroactively applicable to March 1, 2016.

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
