## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act concerning instruction provided through the Iowa
- 2 learning online initiative.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 256.42, subsection 7, Code 2016, is
2 amended to read as follows:

The department may waive for one year the provisions 3 7. 4 of section 256.11, subsection 5, which require that specified 5 subjects be offered and taught by professional staff of a 6 school district or school, if the school district or school 7 makes every reasonable and good faith good-faith effort to 8 employ a teacher licensed under chapter 272 for such a subject, 9 and the school district or school proves to the satisfaction 10 of the department that the school district or school is unable 11 to employ such a teacher. The specified subject shall be 12 provided by the initiative. The specified subject may instead 13 be provided by the school district or school if all of the 14 following conditions are met: 15 The course content is provided through an online learning a. 16 platform by a licensed teacher with online learning experience. 17 b. The course content provided is aligned with school 18 district or school standards and satisfies the requirements of 19 subsection 6. 20 c. The course is not offered by the initiative pursuant to 21 this section, or the course offered by the initiative lacks the 22 capacity to accommodate additional students. 23 The course is the sole course per semester that d. 24 the school district or school is providing instead of the 25 initiative pursuant to this subsection. 26 EXPLANATION The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with 27 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly. 28 29 Current law permits the state department of education to

30 waive a requirement that specified subjects available through 31 the Iowa learning online initiative be offered and taught by 32 professional staff of a school district or school if the school 33 district or school makes every reasonable and good-faith effort 34 to employ a teacher licensed for such a subject, and the school 35 district or school proves to the satisfaction of the department

2 teacher. The specified subject can only be provided by the
3 initiative.

4 This bill provides that if the department grants such a 5 waiver, the specified subject may be provided by the district 6 or school instead of the initiative if certain conditions 7 specified in the bill are met.
