A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act establishing a task force to study issues relating to
- 2 anhydrous ammonia and including effective date provisions.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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- 1 Section 1. IOWA ANHYDROUS AMMONIA TASK FORCE.
- An anhydrous ammonia task force is created within the
- 3 department of agriculture and land stewardship. The task force
- 4 shall study the development and implementation of solutions
- 5 related to the use and regulation of anhydrous ammonia and
- 6 associated innovations related to nutrient management.
- 7 2. The task force shall be composed of members appointed
- 8 by the secretary of agriculture from interested stakeholders,
- 9 including but not limited to persons engaged in the business of
- 10 storing, transporting, or applying anhydrous ammonia on crop
- ll fields. The secretary of agriculture shall chair the task
- 12 force as a nonvoting member.
- 3. Members of the task force shall not receive a per diem,
- 14 shall not be reimbursed for actual and necessary expenses while
- 15 in attendance at any meeting, and shall not be reimbursed for
- 16 travel expenses.
- 17 4. a. The task force shall submit a report regarding its
- 18 findings, recommendations, and any proposed legislation to the
- 19 governor and the general assembly not later than January 13,
- 20 2017.
- 21 b. The task force is abolished on January 31, 2017.
- 22 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE UPON ENACTMENT. This Act, being deemed of
- 23 immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment.
- 24 EXPLANATION
- 25 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
- the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 27 This bill creates an anhydrous ammonia task force within
- 28 the department of agriculture and land stewardship. The task
- 29 force is charged to study the development and implementation
- 30 of solutions related to the use and regulation of anhydrous
- 31 ammonia and associated innovations related to nutrient
- 32 management. The task force is to be composed of persons
- 33 interested in these issues, including persons engaged in
- 34 storing, transporting, or applying anhydrous ammonia. The
- 35 members are to be appointed by the secretary of agriculture,

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- 1 who serves as a nonvoting member and chair of the task
- 2 force. The task force is required to submit its findings,
- 3 recommendations, and any proposed legislation to the governor
- 4 and general assembly not later than January 13, 2017. The task
- 5 force is abolished on January 31, 2017. The bill takes effect
- 6 upon enactment.
