## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the regulation of tanning facilities and
- 2 making penalties applicable.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 136D.3A Use of tanning devices by 2 minors prohibited.
- 1. A tanning facility shall not allow a person under
   4 eighteen years of age to use a tanning device.
- 5 2. a. This section shall not apply in circumstances in 6 which a person under eighteen years of age possesses a written
- 7 order from a health care professional for the use of a tanning
- 8 device determined to be medically necessary by the health
- 9 care professional. A tanning facility shall keep a record of
- 10 all written orders received by the tanning facility pursuant
- 11 to this paragraph. A written order issued pursuant to this
- 12 paragraph shall expire one year after the date of issuance and
- 13 may be renewed annually.
- 14 b. For purposes of this subsection, "health care
- 15 professional" means a person who is licensed, certified, or
- 16 otherwise authorized or permitted by the law of this state to
- 17 administer health care in the ordinary course of business or in
- 18 the practice of a profession.
- 19 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 22 This bill relates to tanning facilities and creates new Code
- 23 section 136D.3A prohibiting a tanning facility from allowing
- 24 a person under 18 years of age to use a tanning device. The
- 25 prohibition does not apply if a person under 18 years of age
- 26 possesses a written order from a health care professional, as
- 27 defined in the bill, for the use of a tanning device determined
- 28 to be medically necessary by the health care provider. A
- 29 tanning facility is required to keep a record of all written
- 30 orders and a written order expires one year after the date of
- 31 issuance and may be renewed annually.
- 32 A person who violates a provision of Code chapter 136D is
- 33 subject to a civil penalty and an injunction restraining any
- 34 violation.
