A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the funding of the statewide interoperable
- 2 communications system and the expenditure of moneys from the
- 3 E911 emergency communications fund.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 29C.23, Code 2016, is amended to read as 2 follows:
- 3 29C.23 Iowa radio interoperability platform Statewide
- 4 interoperable communications system.
- 5 l. The lowa radio interoperability platform statewide
- 6 interoperable communications system shall be under the
- 7 joint purview of the department of public safety and the
- 8 department of transportation. The departments shall jointly
- 9 submit a biannual report to the Iowa statewide interoperable
- 10 communications system board beginning July 1, 2016.
- 11 2. The treasurer of state is authorized to enter into
- 12 a financing agreement in accordance with the provisions
- 13 of section 12.28 for the purpose of building the statewide
- 14 interoperable communications system.
- 15 Sec. 2. Section 34A.7A, subsection 2, Code 2016, is amended
- 16 by adding the following new paragraph:
- 17 NEW PARAGRAPH. Of. The program manager shall allocate
- 18 four million three hundred eighty-three thousand dollars to
- 19 the department of public safety in the fiscal year beginning
- 20 July 1, 2016, and ending June 30, 2017, for payments and other
- 21 costs due under a financing agreement entered into by the
- 22 treasurer of state for building the statewide interoperable
- 23 communications system pursuant to section 29C.23, subsection 2.
- 24 Sec. 3. Section 34A.7A, subsection 2, paragraph f, Code
- 25 2016, is amended to read as follows:
- 26 f. If moneys remain in the fund after fully paying all
- 27 obligations under paragraphs "a", "b", "c", "d", and "e",
- 28 and "Of", the remainder may be accumulated in the fund as
- 29 a carryover operating surplus. The program manager, in
- 30 consultation with the E911 communications council, shall
- 31 allocate an amount, not to exceed one hundred thousand
- 32 dollars per fiscal year, for development of public awareness
- 33 and educational programs related to the use of 911 by the
- 34 public, educational programs for personnel responsible for the
- 35 maintenance, operation, and upgrading of local E911 systems,

- 1 and the expenses of members of the E911 communications council 2 for travel, monthly meetings, and training. The remaining 3 surplus shall be used to fund future network and public safety 4 answering point improvements for the receipt and disposition 5 of 911 calls, including hardware and software for an internet 6 protocol-enabled next generation network, and wireless 7 carriers' transport costs related to wireless E911 services, if 8 those costs are not otherwise recovered by wireless carriers 9 through customer billing or other sources and approved by the 10 program manager in consultation with the E911 communications 11 council. Notwithstanding section 8.33, any moneys remaining 12 in the fund at the end of each fiscal year shall not revert to 13 the general fund of the state but shall remain available for 14 the purposes of the fund. 15 Sec. 4. CODE EDITOR DIRECTIVE. If 2016 Iowa Acts, House 16 File 2439 and this Act, if enacted, amend section 34A.7A, 17 subsection 2, by adding new lettered paragraphs before section 18 34A.7A, subsection 2, paragraph "f", the Code editor shall, if 19 possible, harmonize the amendments in those two Acts to section 20 34A.7A, subsection 2, paragraph "f", to modify the references 21 to the lettered paragraphs codified in that subsection 2 before 22 that paragraph "f", so that the references also refer to both 23 new lettered paragraphs added by those two Acts.
- 24 EXPLANATION
- 25 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with 26 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 27 This bill relates to the funding of the statewide
- 28 interoperable communications system and the expenditure of
- 29 moneys from the E911 emergency communications fund.
- 30 The bill authorizes the treasurer of state to enter into
- 31 a financing agreement pursuant to Code section 12.28 for the
- 32 purpose of building the statewide interoperable communications
- 33 system.
- 34 The bill provides funding for such statewide interoperable
- 35 communications system from moneys in the E911 emergency

- 1 communications fund. Under current Code section 34A.7A, a
- 2 monthly surcharge is imposed on all communications service
- 3 providers in Iowa. Moneys collected pursuant to the surcharge
- 4 are deposited in the E911 emergency communications fund and are
- 5 expended by the E911 program manager in a priority order as
- 6 listed in Code section 34A.7A(2).
- 7 The bill requires the program manager, in the fiscal year
- 8 starting July 1, 2016, and ending June 30, 2017, to allocate
- 9 \$4,383,000 of the surcharge moneys to the department of
- 10 public safety for payments due under a financing agreement for
- 11 building the statewide interoperable communications system.
- 12 The bill directs the Code editor to harmonize the amendments
- 13 to Code section 34A.7A(2), paragraph "f", in 2016 Iowa Acts,
- 14 House File 2439 and this bill, if enacted.
