A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to collectors of antique vehicles, providing
2 fees, and making a penalty applicable.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 321.34, Code 2015, is amended by adding
2 the following new subsection:

3 NEW SUBSECTION. 28. *a.* An owner referred to in subsection
4 12, upon written application to the department pursuant to
5 section 321.115, subsection 1A, paragraph "a", may order
6 special registration plates with an antique vehicle collector
7 emblem pursuant to this subsection. The antique vehicle
8 collector emblem shall be designed by the department.

9 *b.* An antique vehicle collector designated by the department
10 pursuant to section 321.115, subsection 1A, shall be issued one
11 set of registration plates with an antique vehicle collector
12 emblem, without payment of a special fee. The special fee
13 for an additional set of registration plates with an antique
14 vehicle collector emblem is fifty dollars. The special fee
15 for personalized registration plates with an antique vehicle
16 collector emblem is twenty-five dollars in addition to any
17 other special fee required by this paragraph "b". The annual
18 fee for registration plates with an antique vehicle collector
19 emblem is one hundred dollars, and is fifteen dollars for each
20 set of personalized registration plates which shall be paid in
21 addition to the regular annual registration fee.

22 *c.* The special fees collected by the director under this
23 subsection shall be paid monthly to the treasurer of state and
24 deposited in the road use tax fund.

25 Sec. 2. Section 321.115, subsection 1, paragraph a, Code
26 2015, is amended to read as follows:

27 *a.* A motor vehicle twenty-five years old or older may be
28 registered as an antique vehicle. The Except as provided in
29 subsection 1A, the annual registration fee is the fee provided
30 in section 321.113, 321.122, or 321.124.

31 Sec. 3. Section 321.115, Code 2015, is amended by adding the
32 following new subsection:

33 NEW SUBSECTION. 1A. *a.* A person may register one or more
34 antique vehicles and be designated as a collector of antique
35 vehicles for the purposes of this subsection and section

1 321.34, subsection 28, after submitting a written application
2 to the department that includes the person's name, address,
3 and driver's license number, and the make, model, year of
4 manufacture, and vehicle identification number, if applicable,
5 of each antique vehicle in the collector's fleet that the
6 collector wishes to register pursuant to this subsection.
7 The application shall be accompanied by proof of financial
8 liability coverage, as defined in section 321.1, subsection
9 24B, for each antique vehicle registered in this way, and
10 payment of five hundred dollars. A person designated as a
11 collector of antique vehicles pursuant to this subsection
12 shall be issued one set of registration plates pursuant to
13 section 321.34, subsection 28. However, the person may be
14 issued an additional set of registration plates pursuant to
15 section 321.34, subsection 28, upon request and payment of the
16 applicable fee. The registration plates may be attached to any
17 of the antique vehicles registered in the fleet of the antique
18 vehicle collector.

19 *b.* The annual registration fee for an antique vehicle
20 registered as part of a collector's fleet pursuant to this
21 subsection is thirty dollars. A person designated as a
22 collector of antique vehicles may register with the department
23 an additional antique vehicle as part of the collector's fleet
24 at any time for a fee of thirty dollars.

25 *c.* Registration plates issued pursuant to section 321.34,
26 subsection 28, to a collector of antique vehicles shall not
27 be used on any vehicle that is not registered as part of
28 the antique vehicle collector's fleet. An antique vehicle
29 registered as part of an antique vehicle collector's fleet
30 shall not be operated without displaying registration plates
31 issued to the collector pursuant to this subsection.

32 EXPLANATION

33 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
34 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

35 This bill provides for special vehicle registration

1 plates with an antique vehicle collector emblem. A person
2 may register one or more antique vehicles, be designated
3 as a collector of antique vehicles, and receive one set of
4 special registration plates with an antique vehicle collector
5 emblem after submitting an application to the department
6 of transportation and paying a fee of \$500. Personalized
7 registration plates with an antique vehicle collector emblem
8 are an additional \$25.

9 The bill requires the application for the antique vehicle
10 collector designation to include the collector's name, address,
11 and driver's license number, and the make, model, year of
12 manufacture, and vehicle identification number, if applicable,
13 of each antique vehicle in the collector's fleet that the
14 collector wishes to register. The application shall be
15 accompanied by proof of financial liability coverage for each
16 antique vehicle registered in this way.

17 Registration plates with an antique vehicle collector emblem
18 may be attached to any of the antique vehicles registered in
19 a collector's fleet. A collector of antique vehicles may be
20 issued an additional set of registration plates for a fee of
21 \$50. The annual fee for registration plates with an antique
22 vehicle collector emblem is \$100. The annual registration fee
23 for each vehicle in a collector's fleet is \$30. A collector
24 may register an additional vehicle as part of the collector's
25 fleet with the department at any time for a fee of \$30.

26 The bill provides that registration plates with an
27 antique vehicle collector emblem issued to a collector of
28 antique vehicles shall not be used on any vehicle that is
29 not registered as part of the collector's fleet. An antique
30 vehicle registered as part of an antique vehicle collector's
31 fleet shall not be operated without displaying registration
32 plates issued to the collector pursuant to this subsection.
33 The scheduled fine for violating these provisions is \$30.
