A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act requiring the racing and gaming commission to conduct a
- 2 study on exchange wagering.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

S.F. 438

- 1 Section 1. RACING AND GAMING COMMISSION EXCHANGE
 2 WAGERING STUDY.
- The state racing and gaming commission shall conduct
- 4 a study concerning the possible authorization of exchange
- 5 wagering, a form of wagering in which two or more persons place
- 6 identically opposing wagers in a given market, as a form of
- 7 pari-mutuel wagering in Iowa. The study shall consider the
- 8 current state of pari-mutuel wagering in Iowa, the potential
- 9 revenue impact of authorizing exchange wagering, the possible
- 10 regulatory framework necessary if exchange wagering is
- 11 authorized for licensees regulated under chapter 99D, including
- 12 any necessary consumer protections, the manner of collecting
- 13 wagering taxes for exchange wagering, and the general impact
- 14 of authorizing exchange wagering as a form of pari-mutuel
- 15 wagering.
- 16 2. In conducting the study, the commission shall consult
- 17 with the Iowa horsemen's benevolent and protective association,
- 18 and may consult with the horse racetrack located in Polk county
- 19 and any other parties the commission deems necessary.
- 20 3. The commission shall submit a written report on its
- 21 findings to the general assembly by December 1, 2015. The
- 22 commission is not required to make specific recommendations
- 23 regarding the legalization of exchange wagering in Iowa. The
- 24 cost of the study shall be treated as an additional cost to the
- 25 racing and gaming commission.
- 26 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 29 This bill requires the state racing and gaming commission
- 30 to conduct a study on the possibility of authorizing exchange
- 31 wagering as a form of pari-mutuel wagering in Iowa. The
- 32 bill requires the commission to consider the financial and
- 33 regulatory impact of allowing exchange wagering in conducting
- 34 the study. The bill requires the commission to submit a report
- 35 on its findings to the general assembly by December 1, 2015.
