A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to licensure of retired volunteer dentists and
- 2 dental hygienists.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 153.23 Retired volunteer license.
- Upon application and qualification, the board may issue
- 3 a retired volunteer license to a dentist or dental hygienist
- 4 who has held an active license to practice dentistry or dental
- 5 hygiene within the past five years, and who has retired from
- 6 the practice of dentistry or dental hygiene, to enable the
- 7 retired dentist or dental hygienist to provide volunteer dental
- 8 or dental hygiene services. The board shall adopt rules to
- 9 administer this section, including but not limited to rules
- 10 providing eligibility requirements and services that may be
- 11 performed pursuant to the license.
- 12 2. The board shall not charge an application or licensing
- 13 fee for issuing or renewing a retired volunteer license. A
- 14 retired volunteer license shall not be converted to a regular
- 15 license with active or inactive status. A retired volunteer
- 16 license shall not be considered to be an active license to
- 17 practice dentistry or dental hygiene.
- 18 3. A person holding a retired volunteer license is
- 19 subject to all rules and regulations governing the practice
- 20 of dentistry or dental hygiene except those relating to the
- 21 payment of fees, license renewal, and continuing education
- 22 requirements.
- 23 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
- the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 26 This bill creates a retired volunteer license for dentists
- 27 and dental hygienists who have retired within the last
- 28 five years. The license is to be issued free of charge.
- 29 Retired volunteer licensees are subject to all rules and
- 30 regulations governing dentists or dental hygienists except for
- 31 those relating to the payment of fees, license renewal, and
- 32 continuing education. The dental board is to adopt rules to
- 33 administer the licenses.
