

**Senate Study Bill 3042 - Introduced**

BY (PROPOSED IOWA LOTTERY  
AUTHORITY BILL)

**A BILL FOR**

1 An Act authorizing the dispensing of lottery tickets and  
2 products by self-service kiosks, and including effective  
3 date provisions.  
4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 99G.3, Code 2016, is amended by adding  
2 the following new subsection:

3 NEW SUBSECTION. 14A. "*Self-service kiosk*" means a machine  
4 or other similar electronic device that dispenses only on-line  
5 lotto tickets, instant tickets, pull-tab tickets, or other  
6 printed lottery products, and that does not provide a visual  
7 or audio representation of lottery game play. A "*self-service*  
8 *kiosk*" is not a monitor vending machine or player-activated  
9 gaming machine for purposes of this chapter.

10 Sec. 2. NEW SECTION. 99G.12 **Self-service kiosks.**

11 1. The authority may operate self-service kiosks to  
12 dispense authorized lottery tickets or products in locations  
13 where lottery games and lottery products are sold, subject to  
14 the requirements of this chapter.

15 2. A self-service kiosk operated to dispense authorized  
16 lottery tickets or products shall meet all of the following  
17 requirements:

18 a. The self-service kiosk shall be owned or leased by the  
19 authority.

20 b. The self-service kiosk shall only be located in a retail  
21 location licensed by the authority pursuant to this chapter.  
22 The authority shall determine, in its sole discretion, the  
23 placement of the self-service kiosk.

24 c. The self-service kiosk may dispense change to a purchaser  
25 but shall not be used to dispense cash winnings for a lottery  
26 ticket or product to a player.

27 d. The self-service kiosk shall not extend or arrange credit  
28 for the purchase of a lottery ticket or product.

29 Sec. 3. **EFFECTIVE UPON ENACTMENT.** This Act, being deemed of  
30 immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment.

31 **EXPLANATION**

32 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with  
33 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

34 This bill authorizes the dispensing of lottery tickets and  
35 products by self-service kiosks.

1 Code section 99G.3 is amended to define a "self-service  
2 kiosk" as a machine that dispenses only on-line lotto  
3 tickets, instant tickets, pull-tab tickets, or other printed  
4 lottery products, and that does not provide a visual or  
5 audio representation of lottery game play. The definition  
6 specifically provides that a self-service kiosk is not a  
7 monitor vending machine or player-activated gaming machine.

8 New Code section 99G.12 authorizes the lottery authority  
9 to operate self-service kiosks in locations where lottery  
10 games and lottery products are sold so long as the kiosks are  
11 owned or leased by the authority, are located and placed in  
12 retail locations as authorized by the authority, and do not  
13 extend or arrange credit for the purchase of a lottery ticket  
14 or product. In addition, the bill permits the self-service  
15 kiosk to dispense change to a purchaser but provides that the  
16 kiosk shall not be used to dispense cash winnings for a lottery  
17 ticket or product.

18 The bill takes effect upon enactment.
