## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act concerning veterans preference information.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. **35C.9 Veterans preference** 2 information clearinghouse.
- 3 1. The department of workforce development shall establish
- 4 a clearinghouse for the purpose of providing information to the
- 5 state, political subdivisions of the state, and veterans who
- 6 are citizens and residents of the United States, concerning the
- 7 rights and duties relating to providing veterans preference as
- 8 required by this chapter.
- 9 2. The information provided, which shall include a written
- 10 statement in plain language concerning the rights and duties
- 11 of this chapter, shall be developed by the department of
- 12 workforce development in consultation with the office of the
- 13 attorney general. The information provided shall also include
- 14 information concerning the enforcement of the requirements of
- 15 this chapter.
- 16 3. The internet site for the department of workforce
- 17 development, the office of the attorney general, and the
- 18 department of veterans affairs shall include a link to the
- 19 information provided pursuant to this section.
- 20 EXPLANATION
- 21 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
- the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 23 This bill requires the department of workforce development
- 24 to establish a clearinghouse for the purpose of providing
- 25 information on Code chapter 35C concerning veterans preference.
- 26 The bill requires that the department develop the information
- 27 provided in consultation with the office of the attorney
- 28 general and include information concerning the enforcement of
- 29 the requirements of Code chapter 35C. The bill requires the
- 30 department of workforce development, department of veterans
- 31 affairs, and the office of the attorney general to include a
- 32 link on their internet site to the information provided as
- 33 required by this bill.
