

Senate Study Bill 3084 - Introduced

A BILL FOR

1 An Act concerning veterans preference information.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 35C.9 Veterans preference —
2 information clearinghouse.

3 1. The department of workforce development shall establish
4 a clearinghouse for the purpose of providing information to the
5 state, political subdivisions of the state, and veterans who
6 are citizens and residents of the United States, concerning the
7 rights and duties relating to providing veterans preference as
8 required by this chapter.

9 2. The information provided, which shall include a written
10 statement in plain language concerning the rights and duties
11 of this chapter, shall be developed by the department of
12 workforce development in consultation with the office of the
13 attorney general. The information provided shall also include
14 information concerning the enforcement of the requirements of
15 this chapter.

16 3. The internet site for the department of workforce
17 development, the office of the attorney general, and the
18 department of veterans affairs shall include a link to the
19 information provided pursuant to this section.

20 EXPLANATION

21 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
22 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

23 This bill requires the department of workforce development
24 to establish a clearinghouse for the purpose of providing
25 information on Code chapter 35C concerning veterans preference.
26 The bill requires that the department develop the information
27 provided in consultation with the office of the attorney
28 general and include information concerning the enforcement of
29 the requirements of Code chapter 35C. The bill requires the
30 department of workforce development, department of veterans
31 affairs, and the office of the attorney general to include a
32 link on their internet site to the information provided as
33 required by this bill.
