- 1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. **279.70 Posting child abuse hotline** 2 telephone number.
- 3 1. The board of directors of each public school shall post
- 4 at each attendance center in a clearly visible location in a
- 5 public area that is readily accessible to students a sign in
- 6 English and Spanish that contains the toll-free child abuse
- 7 telephone hotline number operated by the department of human
- 8 services.
- 9 2. Notwithstanding section 256F.4, subsection 2, a charter
- 10 school is subject to and shall comply with the requirements of
- 11 this section.
- 12 3. The state board of education shall adopt rules relating
- 13 to the size and location of the sign required under this
- 14 section.
- 15 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
- 17 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 18 This bill requires public schools, including charter
- 19 schools, to post at each attendance center in a clearly
- 20 visible location in a public area that is readily accessible
- 21 to students a sign in English and Spanish that contains the
- 22 toll-free child abuse telephone hotline number operated by the
