## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 7 BY GASSMAN

A Concurrent Resolution specifying a minimum number of
days for legislative secretary salary payments for
the eighty-seventh general assembly.

WHEREAS, legislative secretaries employed as clerks for the members of the general assembly perform a vital and valuable service in facilitating and expediting the work of the members in an organized and efficient manner; and

9 WHEREAS, 2017 Iowa Acts, Senate File 130 limits 10 the receipt by members of the eighty-seventh general 11 assembly of a per diem for expenses of office for the 12 first regular session convening in 2017 for a maximum 13 of 100 calendar days rather than 110 calendar days; and 14 WHEREAS, legislative secretaries will continue to 15 perform essential services for the members of the 16 general assembly until the date the general assembly 17 adjourns; and

18 WHEREAS, 2017 Iowa Acts, Senate Concurrent 19 Resolution 1 limits salary payments for secretaries to 20 32 hours per week but does not specifically state a 21 duration for such payments; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, THE SENATE CONCURRING, That legislative secretaries shall be paid at a minimum for work on a weekly basis during the first regular session of the eighty-seventh general assembly through the last day of the session, or for 110 calendar days, whichever occurs earlier, and during the second regular session through the last day of the

session, or for 100 calendar days, whichever occurs
earlier, even if the members' per diems for expenses of
office are not paid for that period of time.
