- 1 An Act relating to registering as a sex offender for committing
- 2 the criminal offense of assault with intent to commit sexual
- 3 abuse.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 692A.101, subsection 1, paragraph a,
- 2 subparagraph (5), Code 2017, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 (5) Assault with intent to commit sexual abuse in violation
- 4 of section 709.11, subsection 1 or 2.
- 5 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 8 This bill relates to sex offender registration for an
- 9 assault with intent to commit sexual abuse that does not result
- 10 in a bodily or serious injury to any person.
- 11 Currently, assault with intent to commit sexual abuse is
- 12 punishable as an aggravated misdemeanor if no injury results,
- 13 and that offense is defined as an aggravated offense under Code
- 14 chapter 692A. A person who commits an aggravated offense is
- 15 required to register as a sex offender for life pursuant to
- 16 Code section 692A.106(5).
- 17 The bill strikes the criminal offense of assault with intent
- 18 to commit sexual abuse punishable as an aggravated misdemeanor
- 19 from the definition of an aggravated offense under Code chapter
- 20 692A. Thus, a person who commits such an offense is required
- 21 to register as a sex offender for 10 years as required in Code
- 22 section 692A.106(1) and not for life.
- 23 A person who commits such an offense is also subject to a
- 24 10-year special sentence under Code section 903B.2.
