- 1 Section 1. Section 321.210B, subsection 12, Code 2017, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 12. A person is eligible to enter into five installment
- 4 agreements in the person's lifetime. There shall be no minimum
- 5 delinquent amount required to be owed by a person for the
- 6 person to be eligible to enter into an installment agreement
- 7 under this section.
- 8 EXPLANATION
- 9 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with 10 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 11 Code section 321.210B provides that if a person's fine,
- 12 penalty, surcharge, or court cost is deemed delinquent and the
- 13 person's driver's license has been suspended, the person may
- 14 execute an installment agreement with the county attorney,
- 15 the county attorney's designee, or the private collection
- 16 designee under contract with the judicial branch to pay the
- 17 delinquent amount. This bill provides that there shall be no
- 18 minimum delinquent amount required to be owed by a person for
- 19 the person to be eligible to enter into such an installment
- 20 agreement.
