HOUSE FILE 2272 BY MOHR

A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act authorizing a voter-approved increase in the regular
- 2 program district cost per pupil and including applicability
- 3 provisions.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 257.10, subsection 2, paragraph b, Code 2 2018, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 b. If the regular program district cost per pupil of a
- 4 school district for the budget year under paragraph "a" exceeds
- 5 one hundred five percent of the regular program state cost
- 6 per pupil for the budget year and the state percent of growth
- 7 for the budget year is greater than two percent, the regular
- 8 program district cost per pupil for the budget year for that
- 9 district shall be reduced to one hundred five percent of the
- 10 regular program state cost per pupil for the budget year.
- 11 However, under such conditions, if the difference between the
- 12 regular program district cost per pupil for the budget year and
- 13 the regular program state cost per pupil for the budget year
- 14 is greater than an amount equal to two percent multiplied by
- 15 the regular program state cost per pupil for the base year, the
- 16 regular program district cost per pupil for the budget year
- 17 shall be reduced by the amount equal to two percent multiplied
- 18 by the regular program state cost per pupil for the base year.
- 19 Sec. 2. Section 257.10, subsection 2, Code 2018, is amended
- 20 by adding the following new paragraph:
- 21 NEW PARAGRAPH. c. (1) In order to provide regular program
- 22 district cost per pupil equity among all school districts in
- 23 the state, following approval at election under subparagraph
- 24 (2), the regular program district cost per pupil for a district
- 25 shall be increased by the amount per pupil approved at election
- 26 for a period not to exceed ten budget years, and not to exceed
- 27 the amount authorized under subparagraph (3).
- 28 (2) The board of directors of a school district may, on
- 29 its own motion, or shall, upon receipt of a petition signed by
- 30 eligible electors equal in number to at least thirty percent of
- 31 the number of voters who voted at the last preceding regular
- 32 school election, direct the county commissioner of elections
- 33 to submit to the registered voters of the school district
- 34 the question of whether to increase the school district's
- 35 regular program district cost per pupil. The ballot shall

1 specify the amount by which the regular program district cost 2 per pupil is to be increased, not to exceed the limitation 3 under subparagraph (3), the budget year for which the increase 4 will take effect, and the number of years for which the 5 increase will apply. The question shall be submitted at an 6 election held on a date specified in section 39.2, subsection 7 4, paragraph c. If a majority of the votes cast upon the 8 proposition is in favor of the proposition, the department of 9 management shall increase the school district's regular program 10 district cost per pupil by the amount approved by the voters 11 for the budget year specified on the ballot. For an increase 12 to apply to a budget year, the election approving the increase 13 must occur before the school district's budget for that budget 14 year is certified under section 24.17. The school district's 15 regular program district cost per pupil for future budget years 16 shall be calculated in the manner otherwise provided in this 17 subsection including any increases made under this paragraph 18 until expiration of the period of budget years authorized at 19 election or until the increase is repealed at election under 20 subparagraph (4).

- 21 (3) The amount by which a school district's regular program 22 district cost per pupil may be increased under this paragraph 23 shall not exceed an amount equal to the difference between the 24 school district's regular program district cost per pupil for 25 the budget year specified on the ballot and the highest regular 26 program district cost per pupil among all school districts in 27 the state for the same budget year.
- 28 (4) An increase in a school district's regular program
 29 district cost per pupil authorized under this paragraph may be
 30 repealed prior to expiration of the period of budget years for
 31 which the increase was approved after an election at which a
 32 majority of the votes cast upon the proposition is in favor of
 33 repealing the increase. The election at which the question of
 34 repeal is offered shall be called and held in the same manner
 35 and under the same conditions as provided in subparagraph (2)

- 1 for the election on the approval of the increase.
- 2 Sec. 3. APPLICABILITY. This Act applies to school budget
- 3 years beginning on or after July 1, 2019.
- 4 EXPLANATION
- 5 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with 6 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 7 This bill authorizes the voters of a school district to
- 8 approve an increase in a school district's regular program
- 9 district cost per pupil, subject to limitations established in 10 the bill.
- 11 The board of directors of a school district may, on its
- 12 own motion, or shall, upon receipt of a petition signed by
- 13 eligible electors equal in number to at least 30 percent of the
- 14 number of voters who voted at the last preceding regular school
- 15 election, direct the county commissioner of elections to submit
- 16 to the registered voters of the school district the question
- 17 of whether to increase the school district's regular program
- 18 district cost per pupil. The ballot must specify the amount
- 19 by which the regular program district cost per pupil is to be
- 20 increased and the budget year for which the increase will take
- 21 effect. If a majority of the votes cast upon the proposition
- 22 is in favor of the proposition, the department of management
- 23 is required to increase the school district's regular program
- 24 district cost per pupil by the amount approved by the voters
- 25 beginning with the budget year specified on the ballot.
- 26 However, for an increase to apply to a budget year, the
- 27 election approving the increase must occur before the school
- 28 district's budget for that budget year is certified under Code
- 29 section 24.17. The school district's regular program district
- 30 cost per pupil for future budget years is then calculated in
- 31 the manner required under current law including any increases
- 32 made under the bill.
- Under the bill, the amount by which a school district's
- 34 regular program district cost per pupil may be increased shall
- 35 not exceed an amount equal to the difference between the school

- 1 district's regular program district cost per pupil for the
- 2 budget year specified on the ballot and the highest regular
- 3 program district cost per pupil among all school districts in
- 4 the state for the same budget year.
- 5 The bill authorizes an increase in a school district's
- 6 regular program district cost per pupil to be repealed by
- 7 election prior to expiration of the period of budget years for
- 8 which the increase was approved. The election at which the
- 9 question of repeal is offered shall be called and held in the
- 10 same manner and under the same conditions as provided for the
- 11 election on the approval of the increase.
- 12 The bill also specifies that existing Code language related
- 13 to adjustments to a school district's regular program district
- 14 cost per pupil if certain conditions are met provides for a
- 15 different adjustment if certain other conditions are met.
- 16 The bill applies to school budget years beginning on or after
- 17 July 1, 2019.
