- 1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 515.135 Property and casualty 2 insurance appeals costs.
- 3 If a policyholder brings an action under a policy of
- 4 property and casualty insurance to dispute a denial of coverage
- 5 on the property insured, excluding personal property, and
- 6 prevails in the action, the insurer shall be required to pay,
- 7 in addition to damages, all reasonable costs and expenses of
- 8 the policyholder, including costs of inspections, adjusters,
- 9 appraisers, engineers, and any other expenses reasonably
- 10 attributable to the action, including reasonable attorney fees.
- 11 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 14 This bill provides that if a policyholder brings an action
- 15 under a policy of property and casualty insurance to dispute
- 16 a denial of coverage on the policyholder's property insured,
- 17 excluding personal property, and prevails in the action,
- 18 the insurer is required to pay, in addition to damages, all
- 19 reasonable costs and expenses of the policyholder, including
- 20 costs of inspections, adjusters, appraisers, engineers, and any
- 21 other expenses reasonably attributable to the action, including
- 22 reasonable attorney fees.
