HOUSE FILE 269 BY HANSON

A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to school district transportation costs by
- 2 establishing a transportation equity program, making
- 3 appropriations, and including effective date provisions.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. **257.16C Transportation equity** 2 program fund.
- 3 1. A transportation equity program is established to
- 4 provide additional funding for school districts with a
- 5 transportation density factor that is five pupils per square
- 6 mile or less. The transportation density factor for each
- 7 school district shall be calculated by dividing the budget
- 8 enrollment for the school district, excluding shared-time
- 9 enrollment, by the total number of square miles of area within
- 10 the boundaries of the school district.
- 11 2. a. A transportation equity fund is created as a separate
- 12 and distinct fund in the state treasury under the control of
- 13 the department of management. For each fiscal year beginning
- 14 on or after July 1, 2017, there is appropriated from the
- 15 general fund of the state to the department of management
- 16 to be credited to the transportation equity fund the sum of
- 17 five million dollars to be used for transportation equity aid
- 18 payments under this section.
- 19 b. For each budget year beginning on or after July 1, 2017,
- 20 the department of management shall calculate a transportation
- 21 equity state cost per pupil by dividing the amount of the
- 22 appropriation for the budget year under paragraph "a" by
- 23 an amount equal to the sum of budget enrollments used in
- 24 subsection 1 for all school districts eligible to receive
- 25 transportation equity aid under this section.
- 26 c. Each school district that satisfies the criteria of
- 27 subsection 1 shall receive transportation equity aid in an
- 28 amount equal to the school district's budget enrollment used
- 29 to calculate the district's transportation density factor
- 30 multiplied by the transportation equity state cost per pupil
- 31 for that budget year.
- d. Transportation equity aid payments shall be paid by
- 33 the department of management at the same time and in the same
- 34 manner as foundation aid is paid under section 257.16, and may
- 35 be included in the monthly payment of state aid under section

- 1 257.16, subsection 2.
- Transportation equity aid payments received under
- 3 this section are miscellaneous income and shall be deposited
- 4 in the general fund of the school district. However, the
- 5 transportation equity aid amount shall not be included in
- 6 district cost. Transportation equity aid under this section
- 7 shall not affect the receipt or amount of a budget adjustment
- 8 received under section 257.14 or transportation assistance aid
- 9 under section 257.31, subsection 17.
- 10 Sec. 2. EMERGENCY RULES. The department of management
- 11 may adopt emergency rules under section 17A.4, subsection 3,
- 12 and section 17A.5, subsection 2, paragraph "b", to implement
- 13 the provisions of this Act and the rules shall be effective
- 14 immediately upon filing unless a later date is specified in the
- 15 rules. Any rules adopted in accordance with this section shall
- 16 also be published as a notice of intended action as provided
- 17 in section 17A.4.
- 18 Sec. 3. EFFECTIVE UPON ENACTMENT. This Act, being deemed of
- 19 immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment.
- 20 EXPLANATION
- 21 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
- 22 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 23 This bill establishes the transportation equity program
- 24 to provide additional funding for school districts with a
- 25 transportation density factor that is five pupils per square
- 26 mile or less. The transportation density factor for each
- 27 school district is calculated by dividing the budget enrollment
- 28 for the school district, excluding shared-time enrollment, by
- 29 the total number of square miles of area within the boundaries
- 30 of the school district.
- 31 The bill creates a transportation equity fund and for each
- 32 fiscal year beginning on or after July 1, 2017, appropriates
- 33 from the general fund of the state to the department of
- 34 management to be credited to the transportation equity fund
- 35 the sum of \$5 million to be used for transportation equity aid

- 1 payments. The bill requires the department of management to
- 2 calculate annually a transportation equity state cost per pupil
- 3 by dividing the amount of the appropriation for the budget
- 4 year by an amount equal to the sum of the budget enrollments
- 5 used to calculate transportation density factors for all
- 6 school districts eligible to receive transportation equity
- 7 aid. Each eligible school district's transportation equity
- 8 aid amount is equal to the school district's budget enrollment
- 9 used to calculate the district's transportation density factor
- 10 multiplied by the transportation equity state cost per pupil
- 11 for that budget year.
- 12 The bill specifies the time and manner by which
- 13 transportation equity aid payments are to be paid, where such
- 14 amounts are to be deposited by school districts, and designates
- 15 such amounts as miscellaneous income. The bill specifies,
- 16 however, that the transportation equity aid amount shall not
- 17 be included in district cost. In addition, transportation
- 18 equity aid does not affect the receipt or amount of a budget
- 19 adjustment received under Code section 257.14 or transportation
- 20 assistance aid from the school budget review committee.
- 21 The bill authorizes the department of management to adopt
- 22 emergency rules to implement the provisions of the bill, and
- 23 the rules shall be effective immediately upon filing unless
- 24 a later date is specified in the rules. Any emergency rules
- 25 adopted shall also be published as a notice of intended action.
- 26 The bill being deemed of immediate importance, takes effect
- 27 upon enactment.
