- 1 An Act relating to the definition of utility maintenance
- 2 vehicle.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

## H.F. 314

- 1 Section 1. Section 321.1, Code 2017, is amended by adding 2 the following new subsections:
- 3 NEW SUBSECTION. 89A. "Utility maintenance vehicle" means
- 4 a motor vehicle operated by an employee or contractor of an
- 5 entity, including but not limited to the state, a political
- 6 subdivision of the state, or any commission, department, or
- 7 agency thereof, an electric cooperative association, or a
- 8 public or private corporation, in connection with the provision
- 9 of utility services.
- 10 NEW SUBSECTION. 89B. "Utility services" means cable,
- 11 electric, natural gas, solid waste and recycling collection,
- 12 telephone, telecommunication, water, and wastewater treatment
- 13 services and includes but is not limited to the improvement,
- 14 installation, maintenance, relocation, or repair of cables,
- 15 fibers, pipes, utility poles, utility structures, wires, and
- 16 associated right-of-way and other infrastructure associated
- 17 with such services.
- 18 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 21 Under Code section 321.323A, the driver of a motor vehicle
- 22 approaching a stationary utility maintenance vehicle displaying
- 23 flashing lights must approach the utility maintenance vehicle
- 24 with due caution and make a lane change into a lane not
- 25 adjacent to the utility maintenance vehicle, or if a lane
- 26 change is impossible, prohibited by law, or unsafe, the driver
- 27 must reduce the speed of the motor vehicle to a reasonable and
- 28 proper speed for the existing road and traffic conditions and
- 29 be prepared to stop. Under Code section 321.423, a utility
- 30 maintenance vehicle is permitted to display flashing amber
- 31 lights. "Utility maintenance vehicle" is not defined in the
- 32 Code.
- 33 This bill provides that "utility maintenance vehicle" means
