BY COMMITTEE ON TRANSPORTATION

(SUCCESSOR TO HSB 68)

**A BILL FOR**

1 An Act relating to the transfer of moneys collected by the  
2 department of administrative services for furnishing  
3 certified abstracts of drivers' operating records.  
4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 321A.3, subsection 1, Code 2017, is  
2 amended to read as follows:

3 1. The department shall upon request furnish any person a  
4 certified abstract of the operating record of a person subject  
5 to chapter 321~~r~~ or 321J, or this chapter. The abstract shall  
6 also fully designate the motor vehicles, if any, registered in  
7 the name of the person. If there is no record of a conviction  
8 of the person having violated any law relating to the operation  
9 of a motor vehicle or of any injury or damage caused by the  
10 person, the department shall so certify. A fee of five dollars  
11 and fifty cents shall be paid for each abstract except for  
12 abstracts requested by state, county, or city officials, court  
13 officials, public transit officials, or other officials of a  
14 political subdivision of the state or a nonprofit charitable  
15 organization described in section 501(c)(3) of the Internal  
16 Revenue Code. The department shall transfer the moneys  
17 collected under this section to the treasurer of state  
18 who shall credit to the general fund all moneys collected.  
19 If a fee established in this section is collected by the  
20 department of administrative services for a record furnished  
21 through an electronic portal maintained by the department of  
22 administrative services, the department of administrative  
23 services shall transfer the moneys collected under this section  
24 to the treasurer of state who shall credit the moneys to the  
25 general fund.

26 EXPLANATION

27 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with  
28 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

29 Under current law, moneys collected by the department  
30 of administrative services (DAS) for furnishing certified  
31 abstracts of drivers' operating records through an electronic  
32 portal maintained by DAS are transferred to the DOT which then  
33 transfers the moneys to the treasurer of state to be deposited  
34 in the general fund. This bill requires that the moneys  
35 collected by DAS be transferred directly to the treasurer of

1 state to be deposited in the general fund.
