## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the exercise, by school districts, of any
- 2 broad and implied powers not inconsistent with the laws of
- 3 the general assembly, and to the construction of statutes
- 4 related to school district boards and school districts.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. **274.3 Exercise of powers** 2 construction.
- 3 1. The board of directors of a school district shall
- 4 operate, control, and supervise all public schools located
- 5 within its district boundaries and may exercise any broad and
- 6 implied power, not inconsistent with the laws of the general
- 7 assembly and administrative rules adopted by state agencies
- 8 pursuant thereto, related to the operation, control, and
- 9 supervision of those public schools.
- 10 2. Notwithstanding subsection 1, the board of directors of
- 11 a school district shall not have power to levy any tax unless
- 12 expressly authorized by the general assembly.
- 3. This chapter, chapter 257, chapter 257B, and chapters
- 14 275 through 301, and other statutes relating to the boards of
- 15 directors of school districts and to school districts shall be
- 16 liberally construed to effectuate the purposes of subsection 1.
- 17 EXPLANATION
- 18 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
- 19 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 20 This bill relates to the exercise of powers by the board of
- 21 directors of a school district.
- 22 The bill authorizes a school board to exercise any broad
- 23 or implied power, not inconsistent with the laws of the
- 24 general assembly and administrative rules adopted pursuant
- 25 thereto, related to the operation, control, and supervision
- 26 of the public schools located within its district boundaries.
- 27 However, the authority does not encompass the power to levy
- 28 any tax unless expressly authorized by the general assembly.
- 29 Statutes relating to school boards and school districts shall
- 30 be liberally construed to effectuate the authority granted
