A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act requiring an inventory of carcinogens used by the state
- 2 or its political subdivisions.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 455B.381, Code 2017, is amended by adding 2 the following new subsection:
- NEW SUBSECTION. 01. "Carcinogen" means any substance listed
- 4 as a group 1 or group 2A agent by the world health organization
- 5 international agency for research on cancer.
- 6 Sec. 2. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. **455B.387A** Carcinogen inventory and 7 replacement.
- 8 1. a. The department shall annually inventory carcinogens
- 9 used by the state or any political subdivision of the state for
- 10 any purpose.
- 11 b. The department shall produce and maintain a list of
- 12 alternatives to the use of carcinogens.
- 2. The department shall monitor and submit a report to the
- 14 general assembly by January 1 of each year regarding the plans
- 15 of the state or its political subdivisions to discontinue the
- 16 use of carcinogens included in the inventory conducted under
- 17 subsection 1.
- 18 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 21 This bill directs the department of natural resources
- 22 (department) to inventory the state and its political
- 23 subdivisions to determine whether any carcinogens are being
- 24 used. The bill provides a definition of the term "carcinogen".
- 25 The bill requires the department to produce and maintain a list
- 26 of alternatives to the use of carcinogens. The bill requires
- 27 the department to monitor and submit a report to the general
- 28 assembly by January 1 of each year regarding the plans of the
- 29 state or its political subdivisions to discontinue the use
- 30 of carcinogens included in the inventory conducted by the
- 31 department.
