## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act modifying penalties for trespassing.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

H.F. 69

- 1 Section 1. Section 716.8, subsections 1 and 5, Code 2017,
- 2 are amended to read as follows:
- Any Except as otherwise provided in this section,
- 4 any person who knowingly trespasses upon the property of
- 5 another commits a simple misdemeanor, except that any person
- 6 who intentionally trespasses as defined in section 716.7,
- 7 subsection 2, paragraph "a", subparagraph (7), commits a
- 8 serious misdemeanor punishable as a scheduled violation under
- 9 section 805.8C, subsection 11.
- 10 5. A person who commits a trespass while hunting deer,
- 11 other than a farm deer as defined in section 170.1 or preserve
- 12 whitetail as defined in section 484C.1, commits a simple
- 13 misdemeanor punishable as a scheduled violation under section
- 14 805.8C, subsection 11. The person shall also be subject to
- 15 civil penalties as provided in sections 481A.130 and 481A.131.
- 16 A deer taken by a person while committing such a trespass shall
- 17 be subject to seizure as provided in section 481A.12.
- 18 Sec. 2. Section 716.8, Code 2017, is amended by adding the
- 19 following new subsection:
- NEW SUBSECTION. 7. Any person who intentionally trespasses
- 21 as defined in section 716.7, subsection 2, paragraph "a",
- 22 subparagraph (7), commits a serious misdemeanor.
- 23 Sec. 3. Section 805.8C, Code 2017, is amended by adding the
- 24 following new subsection:
- NEW SUBSECTION. 11. Trespassing violations. For trespasses
- 26 punishable under section 716.8, subsection 1 or 5, the
- 27 scheduled fine is two hundred dollars for a first violation,
- 28 five hundred dollars for a second violation, and one thousand
- 29 dollars for a third or subsequent violation.
- 30 EXPLANATION
- 31 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
- 32 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 33 This bill modifies penalties for trespassing.
- 34 Under current law, a trespass that does not involve injury
- 35 to a person or damages of more than \$200, an intent to commit a

- 1 hate crime, public utility property, or the intentional viewing
- 2 or recording of another person without a legitimate purpose is
- 3 a simple misdemeanor and is punishable by a fine between \$65
- 4 and \$625, as determined by a court. A court may also order
- 5 imprisonment not to exceed 30 days in lieu of or in addition to
- 6 a fine.
- 7 The bill modifies the penalty for a trespass which does not
- 8 involve damages of more than \$200, an intent to commit a hate
- 9 crime, public utility property, or the intentional viewing
- 10 or recording of another person without a legitimate purpose.
- 11 Under the bill, such a trespass remains a simple misdemeanor,
- 12 but is punishable as a scheduled fine. The fine schedule is
- 13 \$200 for the first violation, \$500 for the second violation,
- 14 and \$1,000 for third or subsequent violations.
