- 1 An Act authorizing the department of natural resources to
- 2 establish certain fees at state parks and recreation areas.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 455A.12, Code 2017, is amended to read 2 as follows:
- 455A.12 Gift certificates for special privilege fees at state parks and recreation areas.
- 5 The department of natural resources shall publish and make
- 6 available for purchase by the general public, gift certificates
- 7 entitling the bearer of the certificate to free camping and
- 8 other special privileges at state parks and recreation areas.
- 9 The department shall establish prices for the certificates
- 10 based on amounts required to be paid in fees for camping and
- 11 special privileges pursuant to section 461A.47 455A.14.
- 12 Sec. 2. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. **455A.14** Camping and rental facilities 13 and other privileges fees.
- 14 l. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary,
- 15 the department of natural resources is authorized to establish
- 16 fees for camping and use of rental facilities and other special
- 17 privileges at state parks and recreation areas under the
- 18 jurisdiction of the department.
- 19 2. The fees established by the department pursuant to this
- 20 section shall be in such amounts as may be determined by the
- 21 department based on the cost of providing the privileges and
- 22 the reasonable value of such privileges. Such fees may be
- 23 increased, reduced, or waived by the department for special
- 24 promotional events or efforts or on the basis of special
- 25 seasonal or holiday rates, on a statewide basis or on the basis
- 26 of an individual state park or recreation area.
- 27 3. Fees established pursuant to this section shall be
- 28 considered a specification of prices to be charged for goods or
- 29 services as provided in section 17A.2, subsection 11, paragraph
- 30 *"g"*.
- 31 Sec. 3. REPEAL. Section 461A.47, Code 2017, is repealed.
- 32 EXPLANATION
- 33 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with 34 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 35 This bill provides that, notwithstanding any provision of

- 1 law to the contrary, the department of natural resources is
- 2 authorized to establish fees for camping and use of rental
- 3 facilities and other special privileges at state parks and
- 4 recreation areas under the jurisdiction of the department.
- 5 Currently, the natural resource commission is authorized to
- 6 establish such fees under Code section 461A.47, which is
- 7 repealed by the bill.
- 8 The bill also provides that fees established by the
- 9 department pursuant to the bill's provisions shall be in such
- 10 amounts as may be determined by the department based on the
- 11 cost of providing the privileges and the reasonable value
- 12 of such privileges. Such fees may be increased, reduced,
- 13 or waived by the department for special promotional events
- 14 or efforts or on the basis of special seasonal or holiday
- 15 rates, on a statewide basis or on the basis of an individual
- 16 state park or recreation area. The bill provides that fees
- 17 established pursuant to the bill are considered a specification
- 18 of the prices to be charged for goods or services sold by
- 19 an agency and are not considered rules for purposes of Code
- 20 chapter 17A.
- 21 A coordinating change is made to Code section 455A.12.
