

House Study Bill 196 - Introduced

A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to career and technical education programs and
2 partnerships and including effective date provisions.
3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 85.20, subsection 3, Code 2017, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 3. For a student participating in a work-based learning
4 opportunity as provided in [section 85.61](#), against the student's
5 school district of residence, receiving school district if
6 the student is participating in open enrollment under section
7 282.18, accredited nonpublic school, or community college, and
8 the directors, officers, authorities, and employees of the
9 applicable school district corporation or school.

10 Sec. 2. Section 258.5, Code 2017, is amended to read as
11 follows:

12 **258.5 Reimbursement from federal and state moneys.**

13 1. ~~At the end of the fiscal year, an~~ An approved regional
14 career and technical education planning partnership is eligible
15 to receive, ~~from federal and state funds, reimbursement for~~
16 ~~expenditures made during the fiscal year~~ for purposes allowed
17 under [section 258.14, subsection 6](#). ~~If federal and state~~
18 ~~funds are not sufficient to make the reimbursement to the~~
19 ~~extent provided in this section, the director shall prorate~~
20 ~~the respective amounts available to the regional career~~
21 ~~and technical education planning partnerships entitled to~~
22 ~~reimbursement.~~ State funds received by a school district
23 under this subsection are miscellaneous income for purposes of
24 chapter 257 or are considered encumbered.

25 2. Federal funds received as a reimbursement for allowable
26 expenditures shall be received pursuant to the multiyear state
27 plan adopted pursuant to section 258.3A, subsection 1.

28 ~~2.~~ 3. The director may use federal funds to reimburse
29 approved practitioner preparation schools, departments, or
30 classes for the training of teachers of agriculture, food,
31 and natural resources; arts, communications, and information
32 systems; applied sciences, technology, engineering, and
33 manufacturing; health sciences; human services; and business,
34 finance, marketing, and management. The director may also
35 use such funds to reimburse approved practitioner preparation

1 schools, departments, or classes for the training of guidance
2 counselors.

3 Sec. 3. Section 258.14, subsection 6, Code 2017, is amended
4 to read as follows:

5 6. A regional career and technical education partnership
6 may use funds received from state and federal sources on behalf
7 of school districts and community colleges participating in the
8 regional career and technical education planning partnership
9 to convene, lead, and staff the regional career and technical
10 education planning partnership; to offer regional career and
11 technical education professional development opportunities; to
12 coordinate and maintain a career guidance system pursuant to
13 section 279.61; and to purchase career and technical education
14 equipment on behalf of school districts and community colleges
15 participating in the regional career and technical education
16 planning partnership, including standard classroom consumable
17 supplies other than consumable supplies that will be made into
18 products to be sold or used personally by students, teachers,
19 and other persons.

20 Sec. 4. EFFECTIVE UPON ENACTMENT. This Act, being deemed of
21 immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment.

22 EXPLANATION

23 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
24 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

25 This bill relates to career and technical education
26 opportunities and partnerships.

27 The bill restores a reference to school corporations
28 mistakenly changed under 2016 Iowa Acts, chapter 1108, and
29 includes a reference to an accredited nonpublic school,
30 relating to student participation in work-based learning
31 opportunities.

32 The bill authorizes an approved regional career and
33 technical education planning partnership to receive state
34 funds for purposes allowed under Code section 258.14(6) and
35 provides that any such funds received by a school district are

1 miscellaneous income for purposes of Code chapter 257. The
2 bill amends Code section 258.14(6) to authorize a partnership
3 to purchase career and technical education equipment, including
4 standard classroom consumable supplies other than consumable
5 supplies that will be made into products to be sold or used
6 personally by students, teachers, and other persons.

7 Federal funds received as a reimbursement for allowable
8 expenditures shall be received pursuant to the multiyear
9 state plan the state board for career and technical education
10 approves under Code section 258.3A(1).

11 The bill takes effect upon enactment.
