A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the definition of mobile home park and
- 2 other related terms in the Iowa Code chapters concerning
- 3 property tax on manufactured, modular, and mobile homes,
- 4 residential landlord and tenant laws, and other laws related
- 5 to manufactured, modular, and mobile homes.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 435.1, subsection 6, Code 2017, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 6. "Mobile home park" means a site, lot, field, or
- 4 tract of land upon which three or more mobile homes, or
- 5 manufactured homes, modular homes, motor homes, recreational
- 6 park trailers, travel trailers, or a combination of any
- 7 of these homes or trailers, are placed on developed spaces
- 8 pursuant to a rental agreement as defined in section 562B.7
- 9 and operated as a for-profit enterprise with water, sewer or
- 10 septic, and electrical services available. The term "mobile
- 11 home park" shall not be construed to include manufactured
- 12 homes, modular homes, or mobile homes, buildings, tents, or
- 13 other structures temporarily maintained by any individual,
- 14 educational institution, or company on their own premises and
- 15 used exclusively to house their own labor or students. The
- 16 term "mobile home park" shall not be construed to include a
- 17 campground as defined in section 557B.1.
- 18 Sec. 2. Section 435.1, Code 2017, is amended by adding the
- 19 following new subsections:
- 20 NEW SUBSECTION. 8. "Motor home" means the same as defined
- 21 in section 321.1, subsection 36C, paragraph "d".
- 22 NEW SUBSECTION. 9. "Recreational park trailer" means a
- 23 recreational vehicle built on a single chassis, mounted on
- 24 wheels, which may be connected to utilities necessary for

- 8. "Mobile home space" means a parcel of land for rent which
- 14 has been designed to accommodate a mobile home, manufactured
- 15 home, modular home, motor home, recreational park trailer,
- 16 or travel trailer and provide the required sewer and utility
- 17 connections.
- 18 Sec. 4. Section 562B.7, Code 2017, is amended by adding the
- 19 following new subsections:
- 20 NEW SUBSECTION. 8A. "Motor home" means the same as defined
- 21 in section 321.1, subsection 36C, paragraph "d".
- 22 NEW SUBSECTION. 9A. "Recreational park trailer" means a
- 23 recreational vehicle built on a single chassis, mounted on
- 24 wheels, which may be connected to utilities necessary for
- 25 operation of installed fixtures and appliances, with a gross
- 26 area not exceeding four hundred square feet when in the set-up
- 27 mode, and certified by the manufacturer as complying with the
- 28 American National Standards Institute construction standard

- 30 NEW SUBSECTION. 14. "Travel trailer" means the same as
- 31 defined in section 321.1, subsection 36C, paragraph "b".

- 33 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
- 34 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 35 This bill amends the definitions of "mobile home park" in

- 1 Code chapters 435 (property tax on manufactured and mobile
- 2 homes) and 562B (residential landlord and tenant law) and the
- 3 definition of "mobile home space" in Code chapter 562B. The
- 4 bill adds motor homes, recreational park trailers, travel
- 5 trailers, or a combination of such homes or trailers to the
- 6 definition of mobile home park for both Code chapters. The
- 7 bill also adds modular homes to the definition of mobile home
- 8 park in Code chapter 435. The bill also modifies provisions
- 9 establishing exclusions from the definitions of mobile home
- 10 park under Code chapters 435 and 562B. The bill defines what
- 11 constitutes a motor home, recreational park trailer, or travel
- 12 trailer for purposes of the bill. The bill also modifies
- 13 the definition of mobile home space under Code chapter 562B
- 14 by adding manufactured homes, modular homes, motor homes,
- 15 recreational park trailers, and travel trailers. The bill
- 16 provides that a mobile home park does not include a campground.
